Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training is held from 6 P.M. to 10 P.M. on the second Tuesday of each <u>even numbered</u> month at Fire Station #1, 8815 W. 123rd Street, Palos Park, Illinois 60464. Classes cost \$25 for residents and \$35 for nonresidents, which is <u>payable in advance</u> by check or money order only.
