

Safety in Gardens of Gulf Cove



The Board of Directors want Gardens of Gulf Cove to be a safe place for all residents to enjoy. For new-comers and longtime residents alike, a few reminders are necessary for everyone to

understand the safety equipment and the wildlife

situation which is unique in the world.

The Board has made substantial investment in equipment and training on behalf of the residents. As most everyone knows, Southwest Florida is the lightening capital of the world. To help protect you, a Weather Bug early warning system is installed at the clubhouse pool with a repeater at the Rec Center Pool. When lightening is detected within 10 miles of the property, a long horn blast (similar to a car horn) goes off and a strobe light illuminates at both pools. THE POOLS ARE CLOSED. The pools remain closed when the strobes are still lit. Once the all clear is given, three horn blasts and the strobe lights go out, the pools are open. Please obey these common-sense safety rules at both pools and leave the pool areas



while the pools are closed. Your association maintains two AED (Automatic Electronic Defibrillator), one in the clubhouse and one in the Rec. Center. Staff members are trained in the use of the units and CPR. These units are fully automatic, and they save lives. If you want

to know how to use them let us know. If there is an emergency at your home, use the AEDs in one of the two buildings.

Wildlife in Gardens of Gulf Cove

FIRST AND FOREMOST ... DO NOT FEED or TORMENT THE WILDLIFE!

This is blunt but it needs to be. Gators and vipers are more than just curious pre-historic critters that we share a piece of real estate with . . . they are predators with instincts much keener than humans. They can kill you. Recently, a woman in

Davies died from wounds inflicted by an alligator while she was walking her dog. Another woman south of Miami in a homeowner's association was bitten by a pit-viper in her yard, she lost her leg from the bite.

There is a lot of fresh water in here, a lot of nesting areas for snakes and gators, getting too close to either can be fatal, especially during nesting season. Pit vipers have a tendency to nest in Arica Palms, in high grass areas, up in trees in the crotch of branches and in abandoned birds nests. Gators nest along the waters edge, in high grass areas and rarely but still possible, in a shady area under decks.

We can coexist with these critters by being mindful of our surrounding and taking a few

precautionary measures:

Avoid the areas around the lakes when walking your pets or your children, especially at night. Alligators strike fast and ferociously. Humans are not on gators menu but, a nearsighted gator sampling may cost you life or limb. Small dogs are probably the most vulnerable and gators do eat dogs.

Snakes can be in the bushes or overhead. If have to venture into tall grass, bring a stick with you to stir up the grass ahead of you. Be particularly cautious if reaching into the base of Arica Palm trees, these are notorious for nesting

Copperheads.

If you are fishing, do not gut your fish and throw the guts in the lake or leave them on the shore, bury them.

It should be known that a child was killed near a lake in Gardens of Gulf Cove many years ago.

In this sub-division people have been seen swimming in a lake (absolutely nuts), tormenting gators and vipers and feeding wildlife (Florida approved birdfeeders excluded). Any one of those actions can lead to disastrous results and at a minimum is a death warrant for the animal as we have to remove any "potentially" dangerous animals.

Please be mindful of the natural beauty we all came to Florida to enjoy.
