Our travels today include the breath-taking scenery of the Grand Canyon. We will begin our tour with a film at the IMAX theater

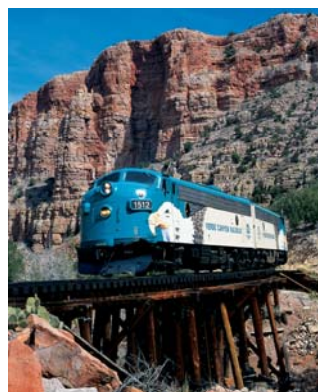

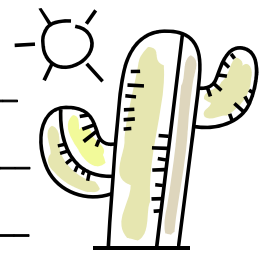
