

Minutes of the Meeting of the Marion Township Planning Commission
June 5, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 by Holloway with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

Holloway made a motion to approve the minutes of the Marion Township Planning Commission meeting of May 2, 2017. Sampsell seconded the motion. All voted in favor of the motion.

Old Business: The sample ordinance on re-cooping costs for emergency services from Mifflin County. Holloway has not completely read this and it will be tabled until next month so everyone can individually review this document. Dillon made a motion to send this sample Resolution No. 2009-1 to Lou Glantz and Sue Hannegan for review and comment. Holloway seconded the motion. All voted in favor of the motion. Holloway will draft a letter to Lou Glantz and Sue Hannegan to send this sample Resolution No. 2009-1 to them for review and comment and ask Sue Hannegan to research for other ordinance samples.

Holloway recapped what was discussed at the May 18th NVJPC meeting at the Bellefonte Borough building. Holloway said there was discussion about a \$5.00 vehicle registration fee which money goes to the county and they can determine how to disburse the funds. It is estimated that the county could see anywhere from \$400,000.00 to \$600,000.00. If Marion Township does see any of these funds we can determine how to spend this money. Also, the comprehensive plan update was discussed and the NVJPC is taking our comments seriously and there will be an Ag Development chapter added. The next chapter to be discussed and reviewed for comments is Police Services Providers. Holloway will send this chapter out by e-mail and would like to make comments by the July Planning Commission meeting.
