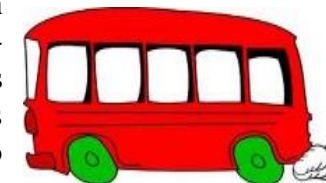

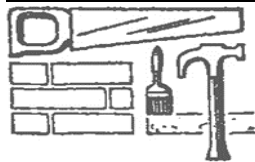

CHURCH RENOVATION UPDATE– MAY 2019: The response from our parishioners regarding the proposed renovation has been very exciting. Your support and enthusiasm are very encouraging. We need to raise another \$300,000. We are fortunate to already have \$300,000 to put towards the project.



We have applied for Restoration Approvals from the Diocese of Peterborough. The Diocesan Finance Committee has to approve a reduced Cathedraticum on our Renovation Fundraiser. We have a quotation from Carlos Nunes and will sign with the contractor after the approval of the Diocese. The contractor is completing all of the costs associated with each part of the plan.

We hope that work will soon begin on the different parts of the project. The work on the church will place some expectations on our community; fundraising and ongoing church cleaning to name just a couple. We will need to respond to these needs as they arise. Some things will be certain.

Daily and Weekend masses will take place in the Church during construction. We are not sure when this will start. A more formal fund-raising campaign will be announced. Envelopes for giving are available at the back of the church. I look forward to the inconvenience of construction... it will mean that the project will soon be completed.
