#### AMERICAN LEGION ORANGE POST 132 PARKING LOT REGULATIONS Effective July 11, 2019

<u>BOTH LOTS</u>: 1. In order to park at the Post, a Post 132 parking permit placard MUST be hanging from a vehicle's rearview mirror or at least clearly visible on the dash. **If you are authorized to park on Post property, your SAF-EST option is to have a valid and registered parking permit issued by the Post 132 Office**. There is NO overnight parking unless specifically permitted.

- 2. Except as otherwise stated here, vehicles not displaying a Post parking permit placard will receive at least one (1) written warning which will be placed on the vehicle. For your convenience, printed warning notices are available from our Bartender or Building Manager. Report the vehicle license plate number and violation date to the Post 132 office immediately.
- 3. Chains securing BOTH lots are secured at Post closing <u>EXCEPT NO CHAIN ACROSS SOUTH LOT MONDAY NGHT/TUESDAY MORNING</u> to enable Monday trash collection from bins.

Towing company is called for violators and a a Post 132 staffer remains to meet the tow company

Violators with disabled placards cannot be towed unless a Post 132 staffer remains to meet the tow company authorize the towing.

Violators with disabled placards cannot be towed unless the Orange Police are called and an Orange Police Officer issues a citation. A Post 132 staffer must be present when the Police Department arrives.

- 4. Towing company (Tows 'R' Russ, 714/639-7877) is called for violators and a Post 132 staffer MUST remain to meet the tow company.
- 5. <u>Violators with disabled placards CANNOT be towed unless the Orange Police Department is called and an Orange Police Officer issues a citation.</u> A Post 132 staffer MUST be present when the Police arrive. After the vehicle has been cited, a Post 132 staffer can call to have the vehicle towed, but MUST be present when the tow company arrives. If the Police never arrive, a warning notice should be placed on the vehicle.
- 6. Any problems/threats: call Orange Police Dept., 714/639-7877, or if necessary, 911.

#### SOUTH LOT

7. Authorized Post users (i.e., Legionnaires, SONs, Auxiliary, Riders) should have a Post 132 placard hanging from vehicle rear view mirror or at least clearly visible on the dash; or be verifiable Post visitors (e.g., Family, Guests, Event Patrons, Vendors/Suppliers). All other users are subject to immediate towing.

#### NORTH LOT:

8. Listreports staff WITH VISIBLE EVIDENCE DISPLAYED on the front dash or front window have authorized use of the entire lot WEEKDAYS between 6am to 6pm except on public holidays (e.g., Thanksgiving).

During the week (Monday thru Friday from 6am to 6 pm there will be NO Non-Listreports users allowed, After 6 pm and on weekends there Must be a Post 132 placard hanging from rear view mirror or at least clearly visible on the dash.

During the week (Monday thru Friday from 6am to 6 pm there will be NO Non-Listreports users allowed, After 6 pm and on weekends there Must be a Post 132 placard hanging from rear view mirror or at least clearly visible on the dash.

9. During the week, Monday thru Friday from 6am to 6 pm, NO non-Listreports user parking is allowed, After 6 pm and on weekends, non-Listreports (i.e., Legionnaires, SONs, Auxiliary, Riders, Family) users may use the lot but should display a Post 132 placard hanging from rear view mirror or at least clearly visible on the dash; or be verifiable Post visitors (e.g., Family, Guests, Event Patrons, Vendors/Suppliers). All other users are subject to immediate towing.
