"I was no prophet, nor a prophet's son, but I was a herdsman and a dresser of sycamore figs. But the Lord took me from following the flock, and the Lord said to me, 'Go, prophesy to my people Israel.'

Today in our Bible lessons we learn about Amos, God's prophet to Israel. We listen as Paul tells us of the blessings we have in Jesus Christ, and we learn of the death of John the Baptist.

In Amos 7 we read of Amos who was God's prophet to Israel. We see Amos stating that he was not always a prophet but was a simple "herdsman" and "dresser of sycamore figs". But God used Amos to do His amazing will.


In Mark 6:14-29 we read the sad story of the death of
