Criteria for Scholar Athlete Award Nominees

- 1) MINIMUM 3.0 GRADE POINT AVERAGE
- 3) EXHIBITED OUTSTANDING FOOTBALL ACHIEVEMENT 4) DEMONSTRATES LEADERSHIP ON AND OFF CAMPUS
- 2) A MEMBER OF THE VARSITY THEIR SENIOR YEAR

 - 5) MAXIMUM OF TWO STUDENT ATHLETES PER SCHOOL MAY BE NOMINATED

Scholar Athlete Awards Frequently asked Questions

CAN A SCHOOL NOMINATE MORE THAN ONE STUDENT?

Yes. Coaches & school officials are encouraged to nominate up to TWO students they feel deserve this honor and meet the minimum criteria.

ARE SIGNATURES OF COACH, COUNSELOR AND PRINCIPAL REQUIRED?

Yes. We do ask for transcripts to verify academic information, or certification from league or CIF officials to verify stats and athletic honors. However, these signatures serve to affirm the veracity of the information on the submitted form.

CAN ADDITIONAL SUPPORTIVE INFORMATION BE INCLUDED WITH THE COMPLETED APPLICATION FORM?

Yes. Up to one page of overflow answers to application questions, and one additional letter of recommendation from non-school official may be included with completed form.

WHERE WILL SELECTED NOMINEES RECEIVE THEIR AWARD?

To Be Determined. Winners are traditionally honored at our annual Scholar Athlete Awards Banquet, held in Spring. A final decision on the 2021 banquet will be included in the congratulatory letters to be mailed to the players and coaches. If the Scholar Athlete Awards Banquet cannot take place, other arrangements will be made to honor and recognized the Scholar Athletes. Copies of the selection letter will be mailed to the student's head coach and principal.

ARE PARENTS, FAMILY MEMBERS, COACHES AND SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS INVITED TO THE AWARDS BANQUET?

Traditionally, yes. Family members and school administrators can purchase tickets to attend the banquet, though typically the number of tickets each award winner can purchase is capped pending table count. If the banquet is held, details on additional ticket purchases will be included in the selection letter.

WHAT IS THE COST OF ATTENDING THE GALA AWARDS BANOUET?

There is no cost to the award recipient. Additional individual tickets for family will have a fee.

DOES THE NOMINEE NEED TO ATTEND THE GALA AWARDS BANOUET OR OTHER AWARDS EVENT TO RECEIVE THEIR AWARD?

Yes. However, exceptions can be made if absence is due to a scheduled school-sanctioned academic or athletic event that he is participating in; a family emergency; or other extenuating circumstances. These exceptions are rare and will be made on a case-by-case basis.

WHEN WILL THE AWARDS BANOUET OR OTHER AWARDS EVENT BE HELD?

To Be Determined. The NFF Board is mindful that football season has resumed for many schools in the region, and we want to let those seasons play out. Saturday April 24 is the date we are targeting, but our final decision will be detailed in the congratulatory letter.
