



Word

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, And the Word was God ... In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men. (John 1:1&4). And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth. (John 1:14) He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God (Rev 19:13) And of His fullness we Have all received, and grace for grace. (John 1:16).

As an ambassador of Christ (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in Christ (John 15:4-5, John 6:56) and one with Him (John 17:22), we come into agreement with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), Jesus Christ, we give thanks to the Lord, the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for you and your family, for the saints, for the leaders that God has raised up on your behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy, so that Christ might make known to you the riches of His glory, we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall for you and your house (Ezek. 13:5); for all the brethren, all those called by the name of the Lord; for the leaders of this nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the well being of God's people; all the people of this nation, and all men, so that you and your family may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. (1 Tim. 2:1-2) In the name of Jesus Christ, we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2). We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God! (Rom. 5:2)

Abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16) we lift up you and your entire house, all of your family, all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time, all those by adoption, and all those by marriage, all your natural seed and all of your spiritual seed. As the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and

is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart, in the name of Jesus (John 16:23), a Minister of the sanctuary and the true tabernacle which the Lord erected (Heb. 8:1), let the Word of God pierce the heart of your family and live on eternally in you and your house throughout all generations, it shall not return to God void, but it shall accomplish what He pleases, and it shall prosper in the thing for which He sent it. It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray for you and your family (James 5:16), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), , and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name.). The words that Christ, through us, speaks to you and your family are spirit, and they are life. (John 6:63) Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Cor. 15:57)

Your kingdom come Lord Jehovah, our everlasting strength, (Is. 26:4). Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Do not hide Your face from Your servants; Hear us speedily. (Ps. 69:17) Beloved, in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers. (3 John 1:2) For you and your house shall go out with joy, and be led out with peace; the mountains and the hills shall break forth into singing before you, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands. (Is. 55:11-12). For the word of our God stands forever (Is. 40:8). The Word is very near you and yours, even in your mouth and in your heart, that you may do it. (Deut. 30:14-16, Rom. 10:8) May the Lord, God Almighty, establish His covenant with you and your descendants after you in their generations, for an everlasting covenant (John 8:31), the word which he commanded, for a thousand generations (1 Chr. 16:15), to be God to you and your descendants after you (Gen. 17:7) Let you and your offspring abide in His word (John 8:31-32), for the counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations (Ps. 33:11). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask, in the name of Christ Jesus (John 16:23), your redeemer (Gal. 4:5), that His Spirit who is upon you, and His words which He puts in your mouth, shall not depart from your

mouth, nor from the mouth of your descendants, nor from the mouth of your descendants' descendants from this time forevermore (Is. 59:21). Let God Almighty establish His word (1 Sam. 1:23) in your family with widespread revelation (1 Sam. 3:1). May it please God to bless your house so that it may continue forever before Him (2 Sam. 7:29), that your seed shall endure forever, and your house as the sun before God. It shall be established forever like the moon, even like the faithful witness in the sky (Ps. 89:36-37). May you and your people be a companion of all those who (Ps. 119:63) fear the Lord. May you have a poor and contrite spirit, and tremble at His word (Is. 66:2), for the mercy of the Lord is from everlasting to everlasting on those who fear Him, and His righteousness to children's children, to such as keep His covenant, and to those who remember His commandments to do them. The Lord has established His throne in heaven, and His kingdom rules over all. Bless the Lord, you His angels, who excel in strength, who do His word, heeding the voice of His word. Bless the Lord, all you His hosts, you ministers of His, who do His pleasure. Bless the Lord, all His works, in all places of His dominion. Bless the Lord, O your soul! (Ps. 103:17-22).

In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray, in the holy name of our Lord Jesus Christ (John 16:23), who is the way, the truth, and the life, that you and your house will be blessed, be undefiled in the way, and walk in the Word of God (Ps. 119:1); that you and your people will seek God with your whole heart; that you will be near to the Lord your God day and night (1 Kin. 8:59) and keep His testimonies (Ps. 119:2), loving them exceedingly (Ps. 119:167) and keep His precepts diligently (Ps. 119:4); that the God of truth (John 14:6) may direct your ways to keep His statutes (Ps. 119:5), to fear His commandments (Prov. 13:13) and fashion your hearts individually (Ps. 33:15); that you and your house will take heed according to His Word, as a light that shines in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts (2 Pet. 1:19) and cleanse your way (Ps. 119:9). For he who heeds the word wisely will find good, and whoever trusts in the Lord, happy is he (Prov. 16:20). May the Holy Spirit (John 14:26) teach you and yours His statutes (Ps. 119:12). May you and your family rejoice in the way of God's testimonies (Ps. 119:14), meditate on His precepts, contemplate His ways (Ps. 119:15) and not forget His Word (Ps. 119:16). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that the creator of all things (Rom 1:25) will not hide His commandments from you and your house (Ps. 119:19) but that your souls shall break with longing for His

judgments at all times (Ps. 119:20). The entrance of God's word gives light (Ps. 119:130) and in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that your souls will keep His testimonies (Ps. 119:129). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your house will rebuke the proud the cursed, who stray from His commandments (Ps. 119:21) and God Almighty will remove from you and your house reproach and contempt (Ps. 119:22). May God revive you and your house in His way (Ps. 119:37) and in His righteousness (Ps. 119:40), according to His loving kindness (Ps. 119:88,149,159), His mercies (Ps. 119: 41), His justice (Ps. 119:149), His judgments (Ps. 119:156), and His Word (Ps. 119:27, 107,154). May the Almighty God make you and yours understand the way of His precepts (Ps. 119:27) and strengthen you and yours according to His word (Ps. 119:28). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that the God of Truth (John 14:6) shall remove from you and your house the way of lying (Ps. 119:29) and that you and yours will choose the way of truth (Ps. 119:30), hate every false way (Ps. 119:104), hate the double minded (Ps. 119:113), and hate and abhor lying (Ps. 119:163). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that the God of power (Matt. 26:64), shall enlarge your heart (Ps. 119:32) and incline your heart (Ps. 119:36) to Himself, to be loyal to the Lord your God (1 Kin. 8:61), to perform His statutes to walk in all His ways, and to keep His commandments and His statutes and His judgments (1 Kin. 8:58) May the Lord turn away your eyes from worthless things (Ps. 119:37), establish His word to you and your house (Ps. 119:38) and revive you and your house in His righteousness (Ps. 119:40). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your house will entreat God's favor with your whole heart that He will be merciful to you and yours according to His word (Ps. 119:58). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that God will deal well with you and your house according to His word (Ps. 119:65), that He will teach you good judgment and knowledge (Ps. 119:66), that He will give you understanding (Ps. 119:73), that you are good and do good (Ps. 119:68). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that God's merciful kindness be for your comfort, according to His word. Let His tender mercies come to you and your house, that you and yours may live and delight (Ps. 119:76-77) and hope in His word (Ps. 119:74). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that the God of love (John 15:10), revive you and your house according to His lovingkindness, so that you and yours will keep the testimonies of His mouth. Forever, O Lord, Your word is settled in heaven. Your faithfulness endures to all generations. You established the earth, and it abides (Ps. 119:88-90). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your house will have more understanding than all your teachers (Ps. 119:99), even more than the ancients (Ps. 119:100). Let you and yours share

in all good things with him who teaches you (Gal. 6:6). May God give you and your people wisdom, which is the fountain of life, to turn you away from the snares of death (Prov. 13:14). May God give you and your people understanding (Prov. 13:15), that you act with knowledge (Prov. 13:16) so that you will be rewarded (Prov. 13:13), and gain favor (Prov. 13:15). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your people will restrain your feet from every evil way (Ps. 119:101), that you will hate every false way (Ps. 119:104), that you and your people will not depart from God's judgments, for He, Himself, has taught you (Ps. 119:102). May the word of God be sweet to your taste, sweeter than honey to your mouth! (Ps. 119:103). Let the word of God be a lamp to your feet and a light to your path (Ps. 119:105). May you and your house praise the name of the Lord, for His loving kindness and His truth ; For God has magnified His word above all His name (Ps. 138:2). How great are His signs, and how mighty His wonders! His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and His dominion is from generation to generation. (Dan. 4:3)

In the name of **Jesus** (John 16:23), who is full of grace and truth (John 1:14), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your house will not stray from God's precepts. That His testimonies you take as a heritage forever, for they are the rejoicing of your heart (Ps. 119:110-111). The entirety of God's word is truth, and every one of His righteous judgments endure forever (Ps. 119:160) As for God, His way is perfect; the word of the Lord is proven; there has not failed one word of all His good promise (1 Kin. 8:56) His word is very pure (Ps. 119:140) and endures forever (1 Peter 1:25). He is a shield to all who trust in Him. For who is God, except the Lord? And who is a rock, except your God? God is your strength and power, and He makes your way perfect. (2 Sam. 22:31-33) May you and your house rejoice at the word of God as one who finds great treasure (Ps. 119:162), love the Word of God and have great peace and not stumble (Psm119:165). May the God of all authority (Rom. 13:1) direct your steps by His word, and let no iniquity have dominion over you and your house (Ps. 119:133) and may **Jesus** redeem you from the oppression of man (Ps. 119:134) and from the snare of the wicked (Ps. 119:110), nor let the proud oppress you (Ps. 119:122) but plead your cause (Ps. 119:154) before your God and Father. Great are your tender mercies, O Lord (Ps. 119:156)! May the great physician (Luke 4:23), send His word and heal you and your people, and deliver you from your destruction's. Oh, that you and your house will give thanks to the Lord for His goodness, And for His

wonderful works to your children! May you and your house sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare His works with rejoicing. (Ps. 107:20-22) We ask, in the name of Jesus (John 16:23), whom God set forth, to be a propitiation by His blood, through faith (Rom. 3:25), that God will accept the freewill offerings of your mouth and teach you and yours His judgments (Ps. 119:108). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray to our Father in Heaven, in the name of his only begotten son, Jesus Christ (John 16:23), that he will give you another Helper, that he may abide with you forever - The Spirit of Truth (John 14:17), to guide you into all truth (John 16:13). Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, honor, and glory, and blessing (Rev 5:12)

In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray for you and your people, in the name of Jesus (John 16:23), who has authority over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to you (John 17:2), that your heart be blameless (Ps. 119:80), that you walk at liberty (Ps. 119:45), trust in the word of God (Ps. 119:42), and may the God of Power (Matt. 26:64), make you and yours bold with strength in your souls (Ps. 138:3), that you not be ashamed. (Ps. 119:46) but with all boldness you and your people speak the testimonies and the Word of God (Acts 4:29), with authority and power (Luke 4:36), giving yourselves continually to prayer and to the ministry of the word (Acts 6:4), the Lord working with you and confirming (Mark 16:20) and bearing witness to the word of His grace, granting signs and wonders to be done by your hands (Acts 14:3). For the word of the Lord is right, and all His work is done in truth. He loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of the goodness of the Lord. By the word of the Lord the heavens were made. And all the host of them by the breath of His mouth. (Ps. 33:4-6).

In the name of Jesus (John 16:23), through whom grace and truth came (John 1:17), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that the word of God will come to your house (1 Thess. 1:5), give you everlasting life (Ps. 119:50) that you and yours shall not come into judgment, but pass from death into life (John 5:24), that you will never see (John 8:51) nor taste death (John 8:52), and may the God of grace (Eph. 2:7, Zech. 12:10), comfort you and yours in your afflictions (Ps. 119:50). Though you and your people walk in the midst of trouble, God will revive you; He will stretch out His hand against the wrath of your enemies, and His right hand will save you. The Lord will perfect that which concerns you and your house; His mercy, endures forever; He will not forsake you and your family (Heb 13:5), for

you are the works of His hands (Ps. 138:7-8). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your people will hear the word of the Lord (Jer. 7:2) and amend your ways and your doings (Jer. 7:3). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that the Lord God will remove falsehood and lies far from you and your house, give you neither poverty nor riches, but feed you with the food He prescribes for you (Prov. 30:8), for you and yours shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God (Matt. 4:4). Glory in His holy name; let the hearts of those rejoice who seek the Lord! Seek the Lord and His strength; seek His face evermore! He is the Lord your God; His judgments are in all the earth. Remember His covenant always, the word which He commanded, for a thousand generations. (1 Chr. 16:10-15)

In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we commend you and your house to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified (Acts 20:32). As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), we ask, in the name of Jesus (John 16:23), the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world, that God will sanctify you and yours by His word. God's word is truth (John 17:17). Let the word of Christ dwell in you and your house richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another (Col. 3:16-17) in truth (Matt. 22:16) and may you and yours increase in faith by hearing, and hearing by the word of God (Rom. 10:17). in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your people will receive the word of God, that you and your family will welcome it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which also effectively works in you and your people who believe (1 Thess. 2:13). May you and your people trust in God, after you hear the word of truth, the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God (Eph. 6:17), the gospel of your salvation: in whom also, having believed, you are sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise (Eph. 1:13), who is the guarantee of your inheritance (Eph. 1:14). May the Holy Spirit fall upon all your people who hear the word (Acts 10:44). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that none among you will hear the word of the kingdom and not understand it (Matt. 13:19), nor allow the cares of this world and deceitfulness of riches choke the word (Matt. 13:22), nor allow tribulation or persecution make you stumble (Matt. 13:21) but rather that all of your people shall receive the seed on the good ground, understand and bear fruit and produce: some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty (Matt. 23:23). Sing to Him a new song; Play skillfully with a shout of joy. For the word of the

Lord is right, and all His work is done in truth. He loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of the goodness of the Lord. By the word of the Lord the heavens were made, and all the host of them by the breath of His mouth. He gathers the waters of the sea together as a heap; He lays up the deep in storehouses. Let all the earth fear the Lord; Let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him. For He spoke, and it was done; He commanded, and it stood fast.

In the name of ***Jesus*** (John 16:23), by the precious blood of ***Christ***, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), may you and your house renounce the hidden things of shame, not walking in craftiness nor handling the word of God deceitfully, but by manifestation of the truth commending yourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God. (2 Cor. 4:2) By the word of God's lips, may you and your family keep themselves from the paths of the destroyer. Uphold their steps in Your paths, O Father, that their footsteps may not slip (Ps. 17:5). In ***Christ*** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your house will lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness (James 1:21) all malice, all guile, hypocrisy, envy, and all evil speaking, as newborn babes, desiring the pure milk of the word, that you and yours may grow thereby, if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is gracious (1 Pet. 2:1-3), and receive with meekness the implanted word (James 1:21), the word of truth (James 1:18), which is able to save your souls (James 1:21) and make you free (John 8:32). But may you and your people be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. (James 1:21-22) Let your hearts be steadfast; and may you and your house awaken the dawn with your praise. For the Lord's mercy reaches unto the heavens, and His truth unto the clouds. Be exalted, O God, above the heavens; let Your glory be above all the earth. (Ps. 57:7-11)

In the name of ***Jesus*** (John 16:23), declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness (Rom. 1:3), in ***Christ*** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your house will continue earnestly in prayer, being vigilant in it with thanksgiving; (Col. 4:2-3) for the gospel did not come to you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Spirit and in much assurance, (1 Thess. 1:5) so whatever you do in word or deed, in ***Christ*** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray you and yours do all in the name of the Lord ***Jesus***, giving thanks to God the Father through Him. (Matt. 4:4) and do all things without murmuring and disputing, becoming

an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity. (1 Tim. 4:12) that you and your people may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, holding fast the word of life, being poured out as a drink offering on the sacrifice and service of your faith. (Phil. 2:14-17) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your people will purify your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love of the brethren, that you will love one another fervently with a pure heart (1 Pet. 1:22), not loving in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth (1 John 3:18), having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever (1 Pet. 1:22-23) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your house will keep His word, and the love of God be perfected in you and yours (1 John 2:5). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your house will love Jesus, keep His word, and the Father in heaven and the Son of God, Jesus Christ, will come to you and your house and make His home with you (John 14:23). Oh, bless our God, you peoples! And make the voice of His praise to be heard, who keeps your soul among the living, and does not allow your feet to be moved. For You, O God, have proved us; You have refined us as silver is refined. Thou we may go through fire and through water; You will bring us out to rich fulfillment. (Ps. 66:8-12)

Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and our God and Father, who has loved you and given you everlasting consolation and good hope by grace, comfort your hearts and establish you in every good word and work (2 Thess. 2:16-17). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray, in the name of Jesus (John 16:23), God's Holy Servant (Acts 4:27), that you and your house will be diligent to present yourselves approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth (2 Tim 2:15). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that God would open to you a door for the word, to speak the mystery of Christ, (Col. 4:2-3), that the word of the Lord may have free course and be glorified (2 Thess. 3:1-3), that you and yours be ready to preach the word in season and out of season. May the Lord God give you and your people the tongue of the learned, that you should know how to speak a word in season to him who is weary (Is. 50:4) for the Lord God has committed to you and your people the word of reconciliation (2 Cor. 5:19). By the word of His power (Heb. 1:3) may you and yours

be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men, for not all have faith. But the Lord is faithful, who will establish you, uphold your steps in His path (Psm 17:5) and guard you from the evil one (2 Thess. 3:1-3). A word spoken in season, how good it is (Prov. 15:23)! As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23) we ask, in the name of Jesus (John 16:23), the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God (Rev. 3:14), that the Spirit of the Lord will speak by you and your people, and His word will be on your tongues (2 Sam. 23:2), that you and yours are able to convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teach (2 Tim. 4:2), in truth (1 Kin. 17:24), not adding to or taking from God's word (Deut. 4:2), but holding fast the faithful word as you have been taught by the Holy Spirit (John 14:26), that you may be able, by sound doctrine, both to exhort and convict those who contradict (Titus 1:9), that the word of God may profit those who hear it and be mixed with faith (Heb. 4:2), so that the word of the Lord might grow mightily and prevail in their hearts (Acts 20:32). Through you and your house may the Word of life (1 John 1:1) grow and be multiplied (Acts 12:24). May God the Most High know your works and set before you and your people an open door that no one can shut; because you and your people have a little strength, and have kept His word, and have not denied His name. (Rev. 3:8). May the God Most High be over your house and may all of your people be ruled according to His word (Gen. 41:40). And now in Christ (Rom.. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray, O God of all authority, let your word come true which you have spoken through your servant (1 Kin. 8:26). Let our cry come before You, O Lord (Ps. 119:169), let our supplication come before You (Ps. 119: 170), our lips shall utter praise (Ps. 119:171), our tongue shall speak of your word (Ps. 119:17), let Your hand become our help (Ps. 119; 173)! Your covenant You will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of Your lips (Ps. 89:34), O God of Mercy. May all these things come to pass by the word of the Lord, and not one word will fail of any of the good things which the Lord has spoken to your house (Joshua 23:14).

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your family, your time and your space, by the blood of the lamb (Rev. 7:14, 12:11). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), Jesus Christ, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be

destroyed. The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein. (Ps. 24:1) The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it. For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. (Col. 1:16) You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created. (Rev. 4:11) As a fellow worker in Christ, a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God. As a vessel of mercy, so that Christ might make known to you the riches of His glory, we claim you and all the people of the earth as the inheritance (Eph. 1:18) of our Lord Jesus Christ. By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom. (Dan. 7:22) Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin. And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is near. (Rom. 13:11) Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it. (Is. 34:1)

Concerning the things we pray for you and your house, we come into agreement with you (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1), being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), and with confidence (1 John 5:14), for God's thoughts towards you and your house are thoughts of peace, to give you a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11), we ask our Father in heaven, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ (John 16:23), a High Priest, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and has become higher than the heavens (Heb. 7:26), believing that you and your descendants receive all we ask for you (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14), petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to you and your descendants according to His word (Luke 1:38), and what we have asked shall be given to you and your house (Luke 11:9). For it is written "Ask of Me, and I will give You the nations for Your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for Your possession." (Ps. 2:8). The counsel of the Lord stands

forever, the plans of His heart to all generations. (Ps. 33:11) God is watching over His word to perform it (Jer. 1:12), and it shall not return to Him void; but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it. (Is. 55:11). It is written: "I have manifested Your name to the men whom You have given Me out of the world. They were Yours, You gave them to Me, and they have kept Your word. (John 17:6) Now, Lord, grant to Your servants that with all boldness we may speak Your word, "by stretching out Your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus.'" (Acts 4:29-30) In Jesus' name (John 16:23) so be it. We will worship toward Your holy temple, and praise Your name for Your loving-kindness and Your truth; for You, O Lord, have magnified Your word above all Your name. (Ps, 138:2) You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations. (Ps. 102:12) For Yours, O Lord, is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. (Matt. 6:13) Amen
