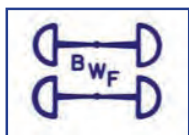

## CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

**Amateur Owner Hunter:** To be ridden by an Amateur Owner or an amateur member of the owner's family who is no longer eligible to compete as a junior exhibitor. Leased horses are not eligible and multiple ownership is not permitted unless all members are of the same family. An amateur who rides for a person outside the family may not ride in a class restricted to amateur owner in the same shows. Amateur Owner rider may, however, ride for other exhibitors in under saddle classes and for other Amateur Owner who have more than one entry in the under saddle class.

**A/O Hunter Classic:** Designated first-round class. Second round approx. 3'3" to 3'6". Horse must have entered, shown and completed the course in 2 A-O Hunter classes over fences. 10 to fill.

**Junior Hunter 3'6":** Open to horses over 14.2 hands and of any age not restricted by previous showing in any division and riders whom have not yet reached their 18th birthday. Any horse and rider combination entered in the Junior Hunter Division may not cross enter in to the Children's Hunter Division or Children's Hunter Pony Division. All horses showing in the Junior Hunter Division must have a current measurement card or valid measurement form issued by USEF. Manners shall be emphasized and extreme speed shall be penalized. Fences 3'6".

**Jr. Hunter Classic:** Designated first-round classic. 2nd rnd. Horse must have entered, shown and completed the course in two Junior Hunter classes over fences at the same show. 10 to fill.

**Junior Hunter 3'3":** Open to horses over 14.2 hands and of any age not restricted by previous showing in any division and riders whom have not yet reached their 18th birthday. Any horse and rider combination entered in the 3'3" Junior Hunter Division may not cross enter in to the Children's Hunter Division, Children's Hunter Pony Division, or any 3'6" Junior Hunter Division. All horses showing in the 3'3" Junior Hunter Division must have a current measurement card or valid measurement form issued by USEF. Manners shall be emphasized and extreme speed shall be penalized. Fences 3'3".

**NJPHA/NJHSA Schooling Hunter 2'6:** Open to all horses & riders. Judged on performance & soundness emphasis on manners.

**NJPHA/NJHSA Suitable Hunter 3':** Open to all.

**PEL Hunter Derby /M&S Bit O'Straw 2'6":** Two-round classic with the option to do both rounds back-to-back. Fences 2'6". Riders must be juniors or amateurs. Horse or pony must have entered, shown and completed the course in two hunter classes over fences at the same show.

**Children's Hunter Pony:** To be shown by a junior exhibitor. Ponies may be jogged for soundness at the discretion of the judge. Class may be combined with Children's Hunter Horse if less than three in each section. To be run in accordance with USEF/USJHA Zone 2 Specifications. Fences 2'6" for Large ponies, 2' for Small/Medium ponies.

**M&S Children's Hunter Pony Classic:** Must have entered and shown in two Children's Hunter Pony Classes at the same show. 10 to fill.

## CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

**Children's Hunter:** To be shown by a junior exhibitor. Riders may not cross enter into class where fences exceed 3' at the same competition except (Children's Jumper, Pony Jumpers, USHJA National Derby, and Equitation classes that do not exceed 3'6"). Horses may be jogged for soundness at the discretion of the judge. Class may be combined with Children's Hunter Pony if less than three in each section. May be combined with adult amateur hunter. To be run in accordance with USEF/USJHA Zone 2 Specifications. Fences 3'.

**M&S Children's Hunter Horse Classic:** Must have entered and shown in two Children's Hunter Horse Classes at the same show.

**Adult Amateur Hunter:** To be shown by exhibitors who are no longer eligible to compete as junior exhibitors, who possess a valid current USEF Amateur Card. Ponies may be shown by adults; suitability to count. Fences 3', spreads not to exceed fence heights. To be run in accordance with USEF/USHJA Zone 2 specifications. May be combined with Children's Hunter Horse.

**Low Children's Equitation:** Open to junior riders who are still eligible to compete as limit riders as of December 1st of the current show year. To be shown over a course of eight (8) fences, with one change of direction. Fences 2' for ponies. Fences 2'6" for horses. Riders may not cross enter into Children's Hunter horse or pony, Pony Hunter or any class at the same competition where fences exceed 2'6".

**Low Adult Equitation 2'6":** Open to adult amateur exhibitors. To be shown over a course of fences 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into any class or division with fences 3' or higher.

**M&S Children's/Adult Medal 2'6":** Open to junior riders on horses or ponies and adult amateur riders that are not competing at the same show in any class with fences at 3' or higher. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at the required height of 2'6' including a combination and two changes of direction after the first fence. May be combined.

**Children's Equitation 3' :** Open to junior riders who have not won six (6) blue ribbons at a recognized show as of December 1st of the current show year. To be shown over at least eight (8) fences 3' in height with at least one change of direction. Riders may not have won any equitation class at 3'6" or higher prior to December 1st of the current show year.

**Children's Pony Medal 2' , 2'6" :** Open to riders in children/adult hunter division. Fences 2' for small-medium ponies and fences 2'6" for large ponies. May be combined with Children's/Adult Medal 3' if entries warrant.

**Children's/Adult Medal 3':** Open to all riders in children/adult hunter division. To be shown over a minimum of eight (8) fences at 3'. May be combined with the Ariat Adult Medal or the Marshall & Sterling Adult medal. May also be combined with PEL Children's Pony Medal.

10 to fill all classes with prize money.

**Mini Stirrup:** Open to horses & ponies ridden by junior exhibitors 10 years of age & under as of December 1st of the current show year. Riders may have never competed in any division at any horse show competition where cantering is required or fence height is 2' or higher. At that time, the rider is no longer eligible for Mini Stirrup Division. Fences are cross rails below 18" or rails on ground.

**Short Stirrup:** Open to horses & ponies ridden by junior exhibitor 12 years of age & under as of December 1st of the current show year. Riders may have never shown in any division, at any show, where the fence height specifications are 2' or higher. To be shown over a course less than 2' in height. To be judged on manners, performance & suitability. Riders may not cross enter into any other division or class at any competition other than Short Stirrup Hunter & Equitation. This division may be combined with Beginner Hunter, if needed.

**Beginner Hunter:** Open to horses & ponies ridden by riders of ANY age. Fences LESS THAN 2' in height. Section A: Rider may not have shown in a division, at any show, where the fence height specifications are 2' or higher. Riders in section A may not cross enter in any division or class at any competition where fences are 2' or higher. The rider will be no longer eligible for Beginner's. Section B: Horse or pony not to have shown in a division, at any competition, where fence height specifications are 2' or higher. Horses may not cross enter into any division or class where fences are 2' or higher at the same competition. This division may be combined with Short Stirrup Hunter, if needed. TROTting ON COURSE NOT TO BE PENALIZED, ALTHOUGH AN UNINTENTIONAL BREAK OF GAIT WILL BE PENALIZED.

**Beginner Equitation:** Open to exhibitors of any age who have not shown in a division, at any show, where the fence height specifications are 2' or higher. To be shown over a course less than 2'. Riders may not cross enter into any other division or class where fences are 2' or higher. This division may be combined with Short Stirrup Equitation if there are less than 3 exhibitors in each section. TROTting ON COURSE NOT TO BE PENALIZED, ALTHOUGH AN UNINTENTIONAL BREAK OF GAIT WILL BE PENALIZED.

**Cross Rail Equitation:** Open to all beginner type riders. Cantering to be done in single file or small groups. Trotting of crossrails is permitted. Height of crossrails not to exceed 18". Riders cannot cross enter into any other jumping division.

**Pleasure Horse or Pony:** Open to all horses and ponies. To be shown in English tack at a walk, trot, canter both ways of the ring. To be judged on performance & soundness with emphasis on manners. No martingales permitted. The class may be split into two (2) separate Sections (horses & ponies) provided there are three (3) in each section. All points to count toward one High Score Award.

**Leap Frog Jumper:** Open to all horses and ponies who, as a horse & rider combination, have not won a total of \$1000 in jumper classes as of December 1st of the current show year. Fences .60m in height, no oxers or combinations.

**Itty Bitty Jumper:** Open to all horses & ponies who, as a horse & rider combination, have not won a total of \$1000 in jumper classes as of December 1st of the current show year. To be shown over fences .70m in height, no combinations.

**Pre-Children's/Adult Jumper:** Open to junior/amateur riders who have not won more than \$1000 in jumper classes as of December 1st of the current show year. To be shown over fences .80m in height.

USHJA Jumper .90m: Open to all.

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

## USEF/Princeton Show Jumping Rules & Regulations

1. The right is reserved to cancel, combine or divide any classes if entries so warrant. In addition, the right is reserved to refuse any entry before the start of the competition without being liable for compensation.
2. All Prize money will be distributed 30%-22%-15%-12%-11%-10% unless otherwise specified.
3. Championships will be offered in all divisions with 3-5 classes except .70m-1.05m and be calculated at 10-6-4-2-1-.5 for hunters Jumpers will be 10-6-4-2-1-.5 except the final class will be 15-9-6-3-2-1 with the bonus class breaking all ties.
4. Prize money will be applied to the exhibitor's outstanding account if any, or mailed to the exhibitor as listed on the entry blank within 30 days of the close of the show provided a W9 has been completed and is on file in the show office showing the taxpayer for each horse. Checks void after 60 days. The Horse Show will not stop payment or duplicate awards for any lost check.
5. A 3% convenience fee will be charged for credit card transactions.
6. If a horse becomes injured or ill prior to being shown in any class, entry fees will be refunded upon receipt of a Veterinarian's certificate. All certificates, to be considered, must be received by show management before the closing of the show. No credit will be given for classes scratched after it has started.
7. Course diagrams will be posted at least one hour prior to each class. Main Show Ring 300' x 200'. Main Warm Up Ring: 220 x 200'. Ring 2: 275' x 160'. Ring 3: 240' x 160' sand footing. Ring 2 and 3 Warm Up: 200' x 160'. Footing in ring 1, 2 and warm ups is the highest International Standard. Full drainage with the very best sand and GGT geotextile throughout.
8. Riders must be properly attired for all classes. Jackets are required in all classes unless waived due to inclement weather. Protective headgear is required at all times when mounted on the show grounds. It must meet or exceed ASTM standards for equestrian use, carry the SEI tag, and be properly fitted with harness secured. Formal attire (white breeches and riding jacket) for Classics and Grand Prix.
9. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have CURRENT MEMBERSHIPS and measurement cards for any and all classes, which require the same.
10. Pre-entries close at 5pm the evening before the show.
11. Enter online via HorseShowing.com or Mail entries to Hunter Farms, 1315 The Great Rd Princeton NJ 08540.
12. The right is reserved to limit the number of entries accepted in any and all divisions. If entries must be limited, they will be selected on a first come, first served basis, selected by postmark date. POST ENTRIES Accepted on a space available basis. Additions & Substitutions to entered accounts will be accepted after the show start at no fee.
13. Numbers will not be issued until a signed, open check is lodged with the horse show secretary and all USEF membership cards have been seen & verified.
14. Horses shown in a class without being entered will pay double the class entry fee.
15. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rulebook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
16. \$50 charge for non-competing horses brought into any show ring for hacking and/or schooling. Back numbers must be worn in Show Rings to verify entry.
17. There will be a \$25 grounds/EMT fee.
18. A fee of \$100 fee will be charged to exhibitor's account for any returned check or declined credit card transaction. After 30 days a \$250 fee will be charged.
19. Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in these rules, the same shall be referred to show management whose decision shall be final.
20. In accordance with GR1301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
21. Breaking ties for other than first place will be done by time taken in the first round.
22. Classes with prize money need 10 to fill unless otherwise stated in the class specs.
23. Riders must be present, as requested, for all presentations, to be eligible for awards.
24. Sharps containers will be available in the show office.

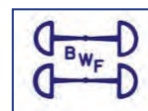
