Probable 2012 fishing limits:

King Salmon: 1 per day, 4 or 5 per year

Silver Salmon: 6 per day

Halibut: 1 per day (under 45" or over 68")

Lingcod: 1 per day, 2 per year (one 30-35", one over 55")

Yelloweye Rockfish: 1 per day, 2 per year

Black Rockfish: 5 per day

## NINILCHIC ALASKA

Our limits have stayed the same here.

2 halibut any size everyday

3 to 6 Silver and Sockeye Salmon per day

1 King Salmon per day 5 total

3 to 6 Silver and Sockeye Salmon per day

1 yellow eye rockfish per day

5 rockfish not including lingcod per day

2 Lingcod over 35" per day starting July 1st through the end of the year.

This year is predicted to be a good salmon year so the May early June Show Specials should score this year.
