absorption of food and slowing the growth of the trout—but that is normal. Once the warmer spring temps arrive, the trout will increase their consumption of nutrients. We couldn't do this without our "Feeder" Volunteers!! Many thanks for your continued support and help getting the fish ready for spring stocking.
