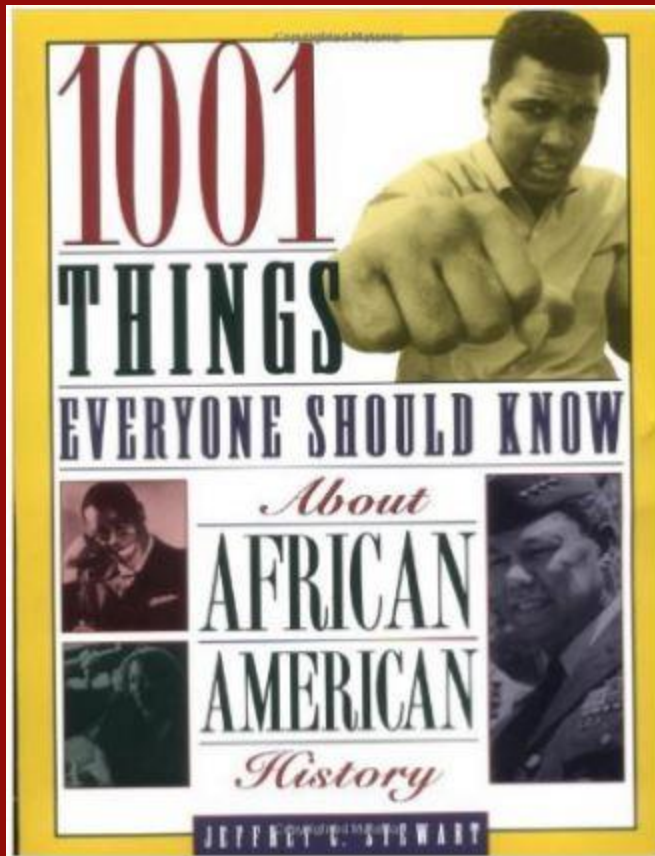


Where can one go to get a comprehensive and entertaining account of the most significant events, individuals and social
