Bicycles for Children and Adults

Folsom State Prison will collect unwanted bicycles to refurbish. The bicycles are later donated to community members in need.



Glasses

The Folsom Host Lions Club will collect used eyeglasses for the Folsom Vision Project, which provides glasses to those who cannot afford them.



Yarn & Fabric

The Folsom Lake Lions Club will collect yarn and fabric to support the Hooks N Needles program at Folsom State Prison, where inmates crochet, knit, and sew a variety of items such as caps, scarves, small blankets and toys. The finished items are then donated to a number of charitable organizations.



Socks

The Rolling Hills Blue Star Moms will collect men's and women's socks for overseas military troops.



LEGOS

BrickDreams— a nationally recognized charity based in Folsom—is collecting unwanted LEGOs for children who have been the victim of domestic violence or abuse.



Purses

Julie's Purse Project will collect new and gently used purses for distribution to local organizations that assist homeless women, domestic violence, and sex trafficking survivors.
