- Registration must be postmarked by April 1, 2020 and received by April 8, 2020 to be considered "first day". Registrations postmarked after April 1, 2020 will be assigned in the order they are received.
- The registration fee is \$65.00 and your check should be made payable to TBA. Your fee will include a boxed lunch on Friday so that you can attend our business meeting. Other meals will be on your own.
- Please list your classes in order of your preference. You may include up to 3 choices. Making only one choice will not guarantee you a space. DO NOT include any class fees at this time.
- Please also indicate the class that is MOST important to you and indicate whether this is your first TBA Convention.
- Class assignments will be sent the week of April 13th. If you DO NOT have an email address, send a SASE (legal size) and your assignment will be mailed to you.
- Your class fees will be due by May 15th. Classes not paid for by that date will be forfeited.

Lodging and Directions

TBA's 2020 Tennessee Basketry Convention will be held at the newly renovated Hilton, Knoxville Airport in Alcoa, TN. They have accommodated us several times in the past, and we are looking forward to working with the wonderful staff again. A block of king and double rooms has been reserved for us, so be sure to book your room at our discounted price prior to June 23, 2020. After this date, reservations will be accepted on a space and rate availability so make your reservation early. The room rates will be \$114.00 per night (plus appropriate taxes). Make sure you mention TBA when making your reservation.

To make a reservation, you may call 1-865-970-4300, Hilton Direct at 1-800-321-3232, or at the Hilton web page where a group page has been set up for the Tennessee Basketry Assoc (TBA) 2020 with a group code of TBA 20. Dates available are July 14-19, 2020.

Directions:

- From I40 East or West, take the Alcoa Highway exit 386B (Airport, Alcoa Hwy/US 129S). Travel south from Knoxville approximately 12 miles. Immediately past the Knoxville Airport on your right is the entrance to the Hilton.

- If you are coming from the North and taking I75S, do not take the Bypass, but take I275 into Knoxville and turn onto I40W. The next exit will be Alcoa Highway exit 386B (Airport, Alcoa Hwy/US 129S). Travel south from Knoxville approximately 12 miles. Immediately past the Knoxville Airport on your right is the entrance to the Hilton.
- If you are coming from the south and taking I75N, exit at Lenoir City and take US95/US321 toward Maryville and the Smoky Mountains (approximately 20+miles). Stay on US321 until you make a left turn onto Alcoa Highway going north toward Knoxville. After you pass the Hunt Road exit, you will pass under a bridge. Make an immediate left into the Hilton entrance.

Want to make it an extra special convention? Bring the family and extend your stay and enjoy the many attractions in the area: Smoky Mountains Heritage Center, Knoxville's Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, the Knoxville Zoo, and the Hazen Historical Museum. You are also close to Pigeon Forge and Gatlinburg, so you can "shop until you drop", visit wonderful craft people, Arrowmont, and of course the Smoky Mountains.
