Criteria:	Scholarship eligibility criteria include (a) a minimum GPA of 2.80/4.00 (overall and in the major); (b) at least a 20 ACT composite score or a 1410 SAT (940 Old SAT) composite score (for incoming freshmen); (c) grades in mathematics and sciences courses; (d) intention to pursue full-time (minimum of 15 hours/semester) undergraduate studies at SUBR leading to a baccalaureate degrees in a science, technology, and mathematics discipline, not to lead to the practice of medicine; (e) intentions to pursue graduate studies (preferably leading to the Ph.D. degree) in the specified areas (not to include the practice of medicine) after obtaining the baccalaureate degree; (f) need, as verified by Financial Aid. Students are evaluated each semester for retention and continuation of scholarship status; and (g) United States citizenship.
