

KNOW YOUR FAITH

IHS—Jesus Christ

Recently a parishioner asked—Fr. What does the letters **IHS** mean on the altar?



IHS simply stands for the name Jesus Christ.

It is a symbolic monogram used by the Roman Catholic Church, it is also known as a Christogram. IHS is derived from the first 3 letters of the name Iesous (Greek for Jesus), iota, eta, sigma. The Greek letter *eta* was replaced by the Latin as "H", while the letter *sigma* became the letter "S" or "C". Occasionally "IHC" instead of "IHS" can be found in churches and on religious items.

This very important symbol is sometimes mistaken as an abbreviation of the Latin phrase "Iesus Hominum Salvator" which means "Jesus, Savior of Man", which relates to the story of Constantine,

whose vision of the Chi-Rho was recorded by Church Fr. Eusebius. In the vision, Constantine was reported to have heard a voice proclaim, "In this symbol, thou shalt conquer". But in fact these letters have a very simple and sacred meaning— Jesus Christ. It was popularized in the fifteenth century by a Franciscan disciple, Bernadine of Sienna as a symbol of peace. In 1541, St. Ignatius Loyola adopted the symbol with 3 nails below and surrounded by the sun as the seal of the Jesuit Order.

Some evangelicals says it is a pagan symbol and have theorized that the initials stand for "Isis, Horus, and Seb", and are related to the Egyptian sun worship, but this is a spurious claim that has never been supported by any solid evidence.

Today the IHS emblem most commonly represents the communion wafer, and is closely associated with the Jesuit Order. (Catholic-resources, symbol dictionary).
