The Popo Agie Conservation District and Maker Space 307 have created a project to help the Lander residents: “SEE” the Popo Agie Watershed and be a part of the Healthy River Initiative

Here's what you do:



- 1** - Look down at the middle of the road, at intersections, near the rain gutters - you will soon be spotting iron storm drains and manhole covers. You will be surprised by how many you find and how different they are.
- 2** - When you find interesting iron work take a picture and upload it to Maker Space 307 Facebook or email it to ironman30717@yahoo.com.
- 3** - We will select 6 manhole covers and /or iron storm drains to be used as printmaking surfaces during Riverfest.
- 4** - At the Riverfest in City Park, August 12, 2017, maps will be handed out for folks to walk, drive, or ride to the 6 printmaking stations and pull paper prints for free - or print on shirts and bags for a fee.
