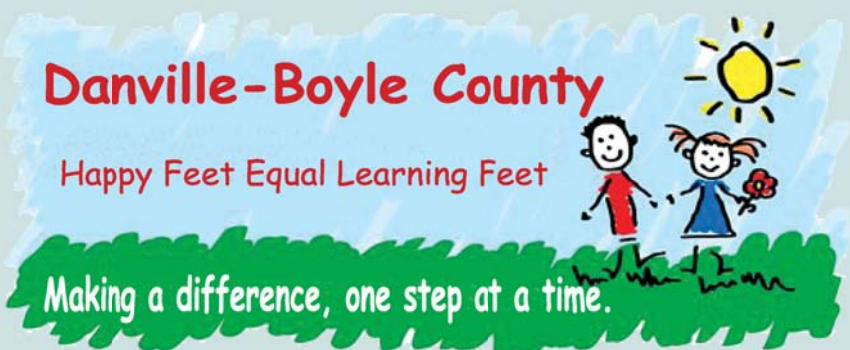

Happy Feet Equals Learning Feet, Inc. is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization dedicated to providing children in need with new, high quality footwear. The program was founded in 2009 by Jerry Baird, a retired coal miner from Union County, Kentucky. He has partnered with Shoe Carnival and utilizes local school's family resource centers and others who work with children in the community to help provide students with good quality shoes.

"A child's physical and mental health is a priority of the program," said Baird. "Not having basic personal items can distract a child from performing well in school. A new pair of shoes can help build self-esteem and can also stop children from being made fun of or being bullied."

Since the Happy Feet Equals Learning Feet Programs started in 2009 it has spread throughout western Kentucky and now into central Kentucky. It is projected that in 2013 Happy Feet Equals Learning Feet will provide new shoes to 6,000 students in Kentucky. In Sept. 2013 the Happy Feet Equals Learning Feet Program as expanded into the Boyle County area.

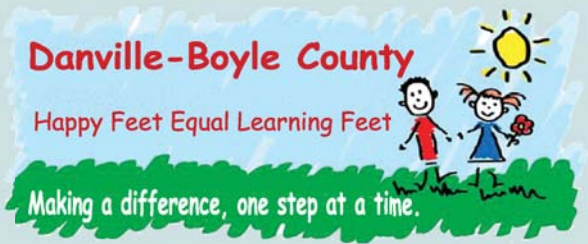
