## CAMPAIGN PRECINCT—Waskah Whelan

There are 14 months to go before Election Day 2020, but the unions' campaign for split-roll property tax has already begun.

Public employee unions have worked for over 40 years to undo Proposition 13, California's historic property tax limitation initiative approved by voters in 1978.

Unions are eager to lay their hands on a promised \$11 billion a year from the initiative - including about \$5.8 billion for K-14 education.

The California Teachers Association is helping bankroll the split-roll measure, putting in millions of dollars from the union's ballot initiative fund to fight for "tax fairness"

The anti-Prop 13 initiative will be entitled **Schools and Communities First** on the November 2020 ballot. No mention of Prop 13 in the title...only "fairness" for schools and communities.

The Schools and Communities First campaign includes groups such as the League of Women Voters of California, the California Federation of Teachers and many progressive socialist groups. They believe *"California "can no longer afford to keep giving billions of dollars in tax breaks to millionaires, billionaires, and big corporations. Creating a split-roll property tax restores \$11 billion for schools, community colleges, and other vital community services."*

Note: The CTA teacher's union collects more than \$200 million annually in revenue and pays no corporate income taxes!

If the split roll, proposal passes it will adversely impact the cost of doing business in California and result in higher prices and loss of jobs. Split Roll could hurt many small businesses that lease property from large business owners.

Howard Jarvis President Jon Coupal: *"We plan an extremely well-funded, aggressive campaign" featuring a broad coalition of businesses and taxpayer advocates. I feel comfortable we will be able to defeat it."*

HJTA.org cannot do this alone. Republican Women need to speak up and carry the message throughout this next year. Voters need to understand everyone benefits from Prop 13. When property owners: businesses, homes and rental properties face higher taxes, we will all be helping to pay the bill.
