BY-LAW NUMBER 2015-032

**Being a by-law to establish playground rules for the playground located at the municipal office.**

Recitals:

The Corporation recently purchased and had installed a playground structure at the Municipal Office;

Council considers it necessary and desirable to establish rules for the use of the playground structure to keep the area clean and to promote safe play.

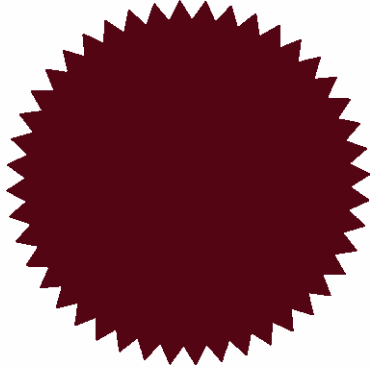
**ACCORDINGLY, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF NEEBING ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. **Scope:** This By-law applies to the grounds of the Municipal Office for The Corporation of the Municipality of Neebing, located at 4766 Highway 61, Neebing, Ontario, and to all buildings and structures located on that property.
2. **Permission to Use is Conditional:** Access to the property is granted to all persons who abide by the rules set out in this By-law. Any person who refuses to abide by the rules is on municipal property without consent and may be ejected and ordered not to return in accordance with the provisions of the Trespass to Property Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. T.21, as amended from time to time (including successor legislation).
3. **Hours:** Access to the property is granted on a daily basis from dawn until dusk. No access is permitted after dark. Access to the building on the property is granted only during normal business hours except with the express permission of the Municipal Corporation.
4. **Users Assume Risk:** Anyone using the property does so at his or her own risk. Parents, guardians and other adult supervisors of minor children using the structure assume the risk on behalf of the children under their care, control or supervision.
5. **Play Structure:** The play structure is designed and intended for children aged 12 and under. Permission is not granted to anyone over the age of 12 years to be on any portion of the structure. Parents, older children and/or other adults supervising children at play may attend near the structure for safety or assistance purposes, but shall not climb or sit on any portion of the equipment.

6. **Supervision**: All children at the play structure must be under the direct supervision of an adult person. One adult may supervise up to ten children at one time. Additional adult supervisors are required for every additional ten children at the site at one time.
7. **Littering Prohibited**: No person shall deposit debris, garbage, waste or litter anywhere on the property except in the appropriate containers provided for the purpose.
8. **Vandalism Prohibited**: No person shall deliberately cause damage to, or deface in any way, any building or structure on the property.
9. **People only on the Structure**: No person shall place a mode of transportation (including a bicycle, a skateboard, roller skates or roller blades) on the play structure. It is intended to support persons only.
10. **No Alcohol**: No person shall bring alcohol onto the property without the express permission of the Municipal Corporation.
11. **Appropriate Play**: All persons using the play structure and surrounding area shall do so in a manner that is safe and is respectful of other users.
  - a) All persons using the play structure and vicinity shall take appropriate care to protect themselves and others from injury or harm.
  - b) No person shall run anywhere on the sand area on which the play structure is situate.
  - c) No person shall push or shove another person.
  - d) No person shall attempt to force another person off of any particular area or portion of the play structure. A person wishing to utilize a portion of the structure which is occupied by another person shall wait at a respectful distance until the first person has finished.
  - e) No person shall use the play structure, or any portion of it, in a manner other than that for which it was designed.
  - f) No person shall use the play structure without appropriate footwear. Bare feet are not considered appropriate.
  - g) No person on the property shall drink beverages or eat food from glass plates, dishes or containers. Food and beverages brought on site must be in unbreakable packaging.

12. Effective Date: This by-law shall come into force and effect on the date that it is passed.
