A Sharp, delicate bouquet slightly reminiscent of almonds with a hint of fresh dough and wild herbs. Light dry, and delicate on the palate leaving a pleasant, fresh after taste of almonds.

Barbadillo Solear Manzanilla

£14.75 £4.50 £6.50

Intense and bright in appearance. Pale straw colour with attractive highlights. Pungent and clean with intensity and finesse from the prolonged ageing under flor. Reminiscent of the sea with saline and iodine notes. Extraordinarily dry on the palate but with a smooth and harmonious finish. Subtle salinity and a lingering flavour.

2. Pol Roger Brut Reserve

Clean, floral, elegant and with a delicious biscuity flavour

3. Pol Roger Rich Demi Sec

£59.95

Aromas of apricot and beeswax, leading onto a rich, full palate of stone fruit, acacia flowers and honey.

6. Bollinger Grande Année, 2005

La Grande Année is the ultimate expression of the Bollinger house style; rich and full - one of the world's great Champagnes

Sparkling Wines White

7. Nyetimber Classic Cuvée, 2010, England

£45.95

Aromas of pure lemon, mineral and honey tones and a hint of tangerine fill the nose. Lively on the palate with crisp acidity.

8. Prosecco di Valdobbiadene, Trevisiol L. e Figli, Italy

£25.75

Lemon and lime citrus notes entwine with pear and a white flower perfume on the nose. There is a freshness and vibrancy on the palate that makes this wine a perfect choice as an aperitif

Prosecco Le Contesse, Italy

£7.95

Colour light straw yellow and a fine and persistent perlage. It's very delicate with a hint of apple, wisteria and acacia flowers.

Despite the wine's lowly status, the Valdobbiadene region is regarded as one of the best sources of Prosecco grapes, coming from vineyards 300 metres above sea level; here the grape is blended with 15% Chardonnay by father/son team, Eduardo and Paolo Trevisiol. The family tradition is set to continue with Paolo's son Dario already eyeing up his grandfather's shoes as winemaker. Dario is 12 years old. White peachy fruit and stony minerality combine to make this a delightful apéritif Fiona Hayes – Buyer BB&R

9. Castell d'Olèrdola, Brut Reserva Cava, Spain

£22.75

A lively sparkling wine full of pin-prick bubbles and the trademark cava flavours of lemon meringue and mineral hints.

10. Pelorus Cloudy Bay, Brut, New Zealand

£35.75

From a Chardonnay-dominant blend of selected vintages, this is a fresh, apéritif style of sparkling wine. Crisp apple flavours are backed up by a nutty, yeasty complexity from its time on lees.

15. A Taste of Paradise Sparkling 2011, North Yorkshire

£29.95

Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. Bronze medal 2014. The first ever Yorkshire sparkling wine made from the champagne varieties, and by the champagne method. A Delightful elegant white sparkling, with a good depth of fruit.

11. Taste of Paradise Rosé, North Yorkshire

£29.95

Made from Rondo and Seyval Blanc, with a touch of Pinot Noir. An exceptional sparkling rose with good depth of fruit, bottle fermented in the traditional manner

12. Castell d'Olèrdola, Brut Rosado, Cava, Spain

£22.75

Made from a blend of Garnacha and Monastrell grapes, this is an elegant, light and floral cava with lovely strawberry fruit flavours.

Sparkling Wines Red

14. Mitchell Pepper Tree Shiraz, Australia

£35.80

This seductive wine is both fruity and earthy-mature, with spice and mulberry fruit flavours and a lingering soft foamy effervescence.

Alsace White

20. Riesling Reserve, Hunawihr, 2014

£5.95 £7.95 £10.95 £16.00 £29.95

A pale yellow with delicate silver tints. The nose opens with complex notes of lemon, pear and fresh peach. The linear palate shows great attack, with a sharp freshness, typical for this great vintage. The flavours have the same complexity as the aromas, with a delicate finish dominated by lemon and pear.

21. Gewurztraminer, Dopff & Irion, 2014

£27.95

A classic, aromatic wine boasting the typical characters of lychee, lime and spice.

22. Pinot Gris Reserve, Hunawhir, 2013

£29.95

Open and complex with elegant hints of pear and fresh apricot. This typical medium dry Pinot Gris offers nice complexity full of the delicate flavours on the nose. The finish is long and elegant with nice aromas of smoke, apricot and a touch of caramel.

Southern France White

24. Picpoul de Pinet, Morin Langran, 2015

Grown in the sun-baked vineyards of Languedoc, just inland from the Med, where it's a late ripener. A golden coloured, dry wine with a fruity and floral nose of hawthorn, lime tree fragrances and hints of acacia.

25. Viognier, Le Versant, Vin de Pays D'oc, 2012

£20.75

Expressive nose of ripe apricots, juicy peaches and tropical overtones. Enhanced on the palate with rich stone fruits and an uplifting citrus acidity that flows into a lingering finish.

26. Griset, Sauvignon Gris Pays d'Oc, 2014

£4.75 £6.50 £9.25 £13.00 £22.75

A great value alternative to Pinot Grigio. Great flavour without the sharpness of some Sauvignons. Citrus aromas, mandarin and orange. Fresh and dry finish

Southern France Rosé

27. Chateau de Roquefort, Provence, 2014

£5.95 £7.95 £10.95 £16.00 £29.95

Notes of wild strawberry and fresh raspberry leap from the glass. The palate is restrained and delicate with a crisp, vibrant edge. The finish is dry and subtle with great length and flavour.

Southern France Red

40. Chateau Trillol, 2011

£25.95

Stunning wine from Ben Sichel. This Corbier is powerful yet elegant with great structure and an abundance of ripe fruit.

29. OVC Old Vines Carignan, Xavier Roger 2013

£23.75

The nose shows an abundance of intense red berry fruit and hints of vanilla flavours. The palate is soft, full flavoured with a smooth easy drinking finish

Rhône White

30. Condrieu, Chapoutier, 2010 £9.95 £15.00 £19.75 £30.00 £55.75 Ripeness with clarity. Rich flavours and great balance makes this a stunning food wine.

36. Condrieu, Les Ravines, Domaine Robert et Rémi Niero, 2011

£60.00

The use of egg-shaped concrete vats and more battonnage than usual mark out 2011 from previous vintages. The intended result of greater viscosity and fruit definition has been achieved. Refined and refreshing, the 2011 achieves a pleasing interplay between the classic Viognier apricot/peach profile and a gentle spiciness.



Rhône Red

31. Côtes du Rhône Reserve de L'Abbe 2014

£22.95

This is a powerful full bodied wine with lots of red berries and a sprinkle of pepper and cinnamon. Very aromatic with a lovely silky finish. Made from a blend of Grenache and Syrah grapes.

32. Pigeoulet des Brunier, Domaine Brunier, Vaucluse, 2014 £5.75 £7.50 £10.75 £15.00 £25.95 Made from grapes grown just outside the Châteauneuf-du-Pape appellation, this wine is mellow and warm just like a miniature Châteauneuf.

33. Crozes Hermitage Domaine Pochon, 2014

£27.95

An elegant, superior quality Crozes Hermitage which has mature red fruits, white pepper and smoky hints on the nose. The palate is fruity, well-structured and medium bodied with notes of damson and blackberry.

34. Gigondas, Chateau de Montmiral, 2014

£38.95

Ripe red fruit aromas, it has a full bodied flavour, with good, silky tannins. Deep red in colour. The nose is potentially varied, shows stylish red fruit with herbs such as thyme and liquorice, black raisin. The aromas all follow through to the palate, with tasty black berry fruit, almost jammy! combining to a full bodied flavour.

35. Châteauneuf du Pape, Berthet-Rayne, 2013

£45.95

This smoky dark garnet, is anything but an oak bomb; the wood is very well integrated, blending seamlessly with the earth, leather, smoke and black fruit flavours and aromas, and while it's quite lovely now, it has the structure to develop and improve over the next three to five years. Pure, lovely Châteauneuf du Pape character.

Bordeaux Red

41. Château d'Argadens, Bordeaux Supérieur, 2014 £4.95 £6.95 £9.50 £13.50 £24.95 After 12 months in oak barrels, Argadens red is thoroughly modern Bordeaux with lots of concentrated fruit and an attractive, supple balance

42. Château La Tour de By, Medoc, 2009 £6.95 £9.75 £13.50 £19.95 £38.95 With a blend of 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 35% Merlot, 5% Petit Verdot, the medium bodied wine is focused on red plums and wild strawberries with some oak in the finish.

43. Château Corbin, Montagne St. Emilion, 2012 £29.95

A rich core of blackberry fruit defines this powerful red. It has a full body, velvety tannins and deep black and red fruit flavours; dusty mineral and clove notes inflect the finish.

44. Chateau Puy Razac, Grand Cru St. Emilion, 2014 £6.25 £8.50 £11.95 £18.50 £33.95 Textbook Saint Emilion; plum and leafy aromas from the Merlot and floral and blackcurrant notes from the Cabernet Franc. Supple and medium bodied with a smooth texture and a fantastic finish.

45. Château des Annereaux, Lalande de Pomerol, 2007

Opulent and lush on the palate with silky tannins. The finish is lingering.

46. Clos du Clocher, Pomerol, 2009

£9.95 £15.00 £19.75 £30.00 £55.95

With coffee bean, herbs, mint, cocoa and red berries in the nose, this light style of Pomerol is on the fresh side with tangy, red berries in the finish

47. Château D'Angludet, Margaux, 2011

£52.95

It is a delightful Margaux, with pretty cassis and violet fruit and good balance, plus soft tannins and good length.

48. Château Leoville Barton, St Julien, 2003

£99.00

A lovely fresh herbaceous nose of fine cassis, eucalyptus and tarry hints is followed by a powerful, masculine palate with rich blackcurrant fruit, Léoville's classic clout and a typically long finish.

Beaujolais Red

49. Fleurie Montangeron, 2014

£31.75

Of all the great Beaujolais villages Fleurie delivers a particular lively and fruity style of wine that has depth and charm. Lovely soft bitter cherry fruit and a velvety mouth feel make for an enjoyable glass of wine.

- 51. Chablis, Testut, 2015 £5.95 £7.95 £10.95 £16.00 £31.00 Steely dry and clean with a slightly creamy mid palate and fresh crisp finish.
- 52. Pouilly Fuisse, Terroirs, Luquet, 2013 £36.95 An elegant combination of finely balanced white fleshed fruits with ripe and buttery notes and a distinctive flinty minerality.
- 53. Chablis Premier Cru, Montée de Tonnerre, Testut, 2013 £42.95 Medium straw-yellow. Deeply pitched, reticent nose dominated by crushed stone and good minerality. Rich, dry and taut, with tangy lemon and tangerine flavours lifted by piquant crushed stone and steely minerality.
- 54. Puligny Montrachet, Joseph Drouhin, 2013 £9.95 £15.00 £19.75 £30.00 £59.95 A wine of great finesse, distinguished and elegant. The colour is pure and bright, with light glints of white gold. The aromas evoke trees in bloom and white flesh fruit, like white peaches. With age, the aromas evolve towards almond and lightly grilled dried fruit. On the palate, there is a sensation of fresh silkiness. Long and persistent in the aftertaste, ending on an exceptional wealth of flavours, both floral and fruity
- 99. Chablis Grand Cru Les Grenouilles, Testut, 2012 £9.95 £15.00 £19.75 £30.00 £59.95 A simply stunning wine. Intense and complex with a taut structure, deep minerality and concentrated fruits. The oak supports the wine well and the finish boasts the steeliness and austerity of a great Grand Cru Chablis.

Burgundy Red

55. Savigny Les Beaune, Benjamin Leroux, 2010

£44.95

Perfumed and almost floral nose. It is certainly a very stylish wine with just the right volume of tannins.

56. Mercury, Louis Carillon, 2009

£31.95

A prettily perfumed red Burgundy from the gifted Carillon brothers. Impressively complex nose with aromas of spice, dark berry fruit and earth. Concentrated palate with an abundance of juice that stains the palate, while the smooth oak notes frame the polish tannins

57. Gevrey-Chambertin, Dujac Fils et Père, 2013 £9.95 £15.00 £19.75 £30.00 £59.95 Light bright colour and very perfumed. The whole bunches show in a lovely lacy quality. This is a very pretty, relatively light-bodied Gevrey-Chambertin, very persistent and approachable early.

58. Nuits St. Georges, Le Petit Arlot, 2007

£55.95

A very aromatic nose with touches of flowers, spices and tobacco. Soft and delicate, it distinguishes itself by its finesse, freshness and elegance. It is a wine for pleasure with a maturity and characteristic crispness and reveals itself with sincerity and simplicity.

59. Aloxe-Corton, Domaine Follin-Arbelet, 2011

£52.95

Fantastic texture, such suave Aloxe-Corton. Flowery red cherry, strawberry and forest berry fruit with hints of mineral; a fine long fruity finish with a mouth-watering saline touch. This comes from a parcel of vines planted on chalk and limestone soils that produce atypically round, alluring Aloxe-Cortons.

50. Chateau Meyney Cru Bourgeois Saint Estephe, 1996 £9.95 £15.00 £19.75 £30.00 £55.75 Rich aromas of spices, berries, meat and earth. Medium-bodied, with velvety tannins and a fruity aftertaste

Loire White

60. Muscadet sur Lie, Domaine Morinere, 2013

£22.75

Classic Muscadet sur Lie, with good weight and balancing acidity. There is decent concentration of fruit and a clean, saline finish.

62. Sauvignon de Touraine,

Jean-Christophe Mandard, 2014

£4.95 £6.95 £9.50 £13.50 £24.75

Simultaneously weighty and precise, with the perfect balance of rich fruit and sizzling minerality. White peach combines with prickly pink grapefruit and lime, topped off with just a hint of classic sauvignon blanc cassis. A serious wine for such a humble appellation.

63. Pouilly Fume Seguin Père et Fils, 2015

£31.00

Distinct stone and steely palate with zingy lime, unripe apple, nice lingering finish, bone dry, medium bodied and crisp acidity. Excellent with seafood and goats cheese.

64. Sancerre, Les Boucauds

Domaine Claude Riffault, 2015

£6.25 £8.50 £11.95 £18.50 £34.95

Very floral on the nose, with hints of white pepper and peach. Really very enticing and seductive, as if begging the drinker to take a sip. On the palate it does not disappoint, with plenty of rich white fruit and some lemon and lime, and a core of pink grapefruit-like acidity which runs through from start to long, lingering finish. Delicious, with striking vivacity.

65. Vouvray, Sec Vincent Carême, 2013

£31.95

Amazingly pure, with freshly picked comice pear aromatics (with the skin), it's gorgeously transparent, creamy almost, it flows and glides with seamless ease; the cool vintage 2013 providing extra freshness and crunch. Dry with chalky-white citrus fruit, really racy, yet understated, discreet, sublime elegance and water-like essence

Loire Red

61. Saumur-Champigny,

Tradition Clos des Cordeliers, 2012

£23.95

A lovely pure nose of raspberry and a touch of Cabernet Franc spice and pencil lead leads into a bright, vibrant fruit-packed palate and a chalky finish.

67. Sancerre Rouge, Domaine David Sautereau, 2014

£32.95

Bags of ripe Juicy fruit: Strawberries, cherries and cassis. Fine silky tannins and wonderful balance. Sancerre Rouge represents the best value quality pinot noir in France. Great with Pork game and cheese.

68. Coteaux du Loir Rouge, Rouge Gorge 2011

£39.95

For those who have never had Pineau d"Aunis, I can honestly say you are missing out! A truly unique grape variety which is a pleasure to drink. Named after the Robin which appears in the vineyards in Spring, the 2013 is classically Pineau d"Aunis, this is packed with strawberry and white pepper. Very sweet and pretty red fruit, with charming freshness and good tannins. Light, delicate and fine, with excellent definition and a peppery finish. An excellent example.

Italian White

70. Pehcorra, Pecarino, Abruzzo, 2015

£4.75 £6.50 £8.50 £12.50 £22.75

Pecorino is quite full bodied with only moderate acidity, it shows flavours and aromas of yellow fruits, ground white spices like ginger and white pepper, and almonds and hazelnuts. The structure is usually quite firm with a marked vein of minerality.

72. Gavi I Risi, Giribaldi, 2015

£24.95

A straw yellow colour, full of light green reflects. A full fresh perfume with fruity notes which pleasantly mix with those of greens and grass. Full and round in the mouth with a discrete structure and clean sensations of exotic fruit and golden apple. A light acidic note, typical of this wine makes it a pleasure to drink with all varieties of food.

73. Casa Vinicola Bertoldi, Pinot Grigio, 2016

A fresh and fruity wine with a bouquet of tropical and citrus fruits elegant and balanced on the palate

74. Pinot Grigio Rosé, Ca' Solare, 2014 Salmon pink with flavours of summer and hedgerow fruits. £4.75

75. Nero d'Avola, Ishac, Porta del Vento, Camporeale, Sicily 2012

£31.75

A Nero d'Avola varietal. Only perfectly ripe grapes with a good acidity and a not too high percentage of sugarsare used. The grapes are fermented on their skins for twelve month in oak vats, the cap is punched down by hand. The wine is aged in large casks for a year. Dark ruby red in colour, it is a flavoursome wine with rich aromas of ripe soft fruit, sour cherry.

76. Montepulciano D'Abruzzo Cirelli, 2015

£24.95

Deep ruby red color with purple tinge in his youth. Aromas of Black cherry, plum and blackberry. The palate shows a Fresh acidity and soft tannins balance nicely with the juicy fruit provide for an easy drinking yet structured wine.

77. Primitivo Salento,

Fiore di Vigna, Paolo Leo, Puglia 2014

£5.95 £7.95 £10.95 £16.00 £27.95

Ripe aromas of concentrated berries rise out of the glass. This dark purple wine has a dark scent of currants and ripe blackberries with a hint of oak on the nose. In the mouth it is explosive - sun baked fruit flavours mingle with a slight herbaceousness and French oak for a powerful burst of flavour which lasts in the mouth.

78. Barolo DOGC, Giribaldi, 2012

£37.75

Aromas of dried fruit and leather then a rich mouthful with a good balance of acidity and tannin.

80. Chianti Classico Reserva, Villa Cigliano, Tuscany, 2006

£38.75

A stunning wine with a nose of complex notes of cherry, red berries and tobacco. On the palate it shows a concentration of berry fruit, overlaid with hints of liquorice and spicy notes from oak ageing, and a long savoury finish.

Spanish White

81. Rioja Blanco Puerta Vieja, Rioja 2014

£22.75

Clean, bright, pale yellow-green. Intense, elegant aromas with fresh, fruity nuances. Light on the palate with hints of a well-integrated acidity. Balanced finish, leaving a pleasant floral aftertaste

82. Basa, Telmo Rodriguez, Rueda, 2015

£22.75

Packed with crisp, clean yellow plum and white peach flavours. Great balance with a stunning zesty finish.

88. Alba Vega Albarino 2015

£4.95 £6.95 £9.50 £13.50 £24.95

Delicious ripe fruit with a slightly aromatic character. It has a freshness from the cooling Atlantic Ocean breeze making this wine a perfect match to seafood and lighter dishes.

89. Bodega Mustiguillo Mestizaje Blanco 2016

£4.95 £6.95 £9.50 £13.50 £24.95

65% Merseguera, 24% Viognier, 11% Malvasia. From the almost lost indigenous variety, Merseguera, these estate vines are grown organically at Finca Calvestra, at over 900 meters altitude. These vines were grafted onto existing Bobal vines (over 40 years old) where Bobal could not reach maturity due to the altitude. Aged "sur lies" in stainless steel.

Spanish Red

83. Rioja Tinto Puerta Vieja, Rioja 2014

£22.75

An intense cherry coloured wine with pronounced aromas of orange peel and dried fruit along with spicy notes from new wood. Robust and fruity with pleasing tannins and a long pleasant finish. Ideal with lamb and surprisingly good with salmon.

84. Bodega Mustiguillo Mestizaje Tinto 2012

£4.95 £6.95 £9.50 £13.50 £24.95

75% Bobal, 10% Merlot, 7% Cabernet Savignon, 6% Grenache and 2% Tempranillo.

Organic viticulture at 800 meters altitude where traditional farming meets modern techniques in this young wine from Mustiguillo. Varieties are vinified separately and undergo malolactic in a mixture of oak and stainless steel. The final blend spends 10 months in French oak.

85. Bodega Mustiguillo La Garnacha de Mustiguillo 2015

£29.75

100% Garnacha. Our Garnacha is a true survivor in our plateau. Selected elaboration, only unique vintages and less than 10,000 bottles produced. Fermentation in 80hl oak vessels with its own stems.

86. Mencia Joven El Castro de Valtuille, Raúl Perez, Bierzo, 2013

£25.50

A brilliant red cherry colour with reddish edges. An. It has an expressive intense and complex nose, of mature red fruit (strong blackcurrant bush) nuanced and herbaceous, toasty, and slate finish.

87. Rioja Vega Reserva, 2014

£5.95 £7.95 £10.95 £16.00 £29.75

Bright, deep red cherry colour. Intense aromas of very ripe fruit, toast, toffee and spices. Unctuous, velvety and balanced on the palate, with a good, high-quality tannic structure.

90. Steinberger Riesling, Kabinett, Kloster Eberbach, 2010

Dry taste, distinct fruity with melon, honey, good concentration and good acidity

91. Trittenheimer Apotheke, Riesling,

Friedrich Wilhelm Gymnasium, 2003

£34.75

This perfectly poised wine is full of pear and green apple flavours. A generous wine with punchy fruit and excellent balance with bright acidity

German Red

92. Binz Bratt, Pinot Noir/Cabernet Sauvignon, Pfalz, 2014

£26.25

Crimson red with purple tinges, the nose is reminiscent of dark fruits with a hint of wood. On the palate it is a smooth, full-bodied wine with notes of strawberry, black currant and well integrated oak; soft tannins provide structure and aging potential and give the wine a long finish

Croatian White

94. Alba Istrian Malvasia Matosevic, Istria, 2014

Fresh and elegant wine of fine structure and attractive fruit aromas, followed by pronounced minerality, with a hint of bitter almond aftertaste. The wine has unusual longevity for its style. Ageing in the bottle brings more herbal and floral notes to the fore.

95. Hatzidakis, Santorini, 2014

Pale yellow colour with soft golden hues. An elegant wine with bright, fruity nose and long volcanic mineral aftertaste.

Rondo, made with brief skin contact. A lovely rich medium rose, which won silver medals in two competitions in 2014

98. Yorkshire Sunset, Ryedale Vineyards

A blend of Tempranillo (42%), Mataro (38%) and Grenache (20%). Characters of plums, cherries and Spice fill the nose. The Aromas lead into a firm dry palate of blackberries and dark chocolate. In Spanish terms this wine has been produced in the "joven" or youthful style- meaning it exhibits only the vibrant fruit characters of Tempranillo without the encumbrances of sweet or toasty oak.

106. Baby Bush Mourvedre 2011

The vineyard was established with cuttings from the 1853 mourvedre planting (the oldest in the world); light, bright crimson, the medium-bodied palate has attractive red berry, spicy fruit, with none of the fearsome tannins the variety can produce.

107. Elderton Estate Shiraz, Barossa Valley 2012

Plum, blackberry and brambles dominate here. The palate is smoothly-textured and although the concentration is equal to the Greenock One, the wine is more opulent with a rounder, velvety more approachable feel. Fruit and spice linger on the finish.

Peachy Canyon's 18 HA of vineyards are particularly renowned for the individuality and vibrancy of their zinfandels. Zinfandel is California's most distinctive red grape and is one of the few that is considered one of their "own", even though it originated in Europe.

After vinification, Zinfandel wines are often matured in American Oak, which gives them a vanilla dimension. There is no single flavour character that can be associated with the grape – it can produce light, jammy, almost Beaujolais- type wines, redolent of freshly crushed berries, through to full-bodied, robust, oak aged wines brimming with ripe, peppery, cassis-like fruits. The best can age marvellously.

136. Bonny Doon Le Cigare Volant, Santa Cruz, 2009

Grenache from our former Ca' del Solo estate (a quarter of the blend) adds rich black fruit flavours and a discreet spiciness. Syrah is principally sourced from Bien Nacido vineyard in Santa Maria Valley, which produces the closest analogue we have found to a Northern Rhône Syrah—tannic and meaty in the lower registers; peppery, fruitful and delicately floral in the top, all the while showing great balance and harmony. A small amount of ultra-low-yielding hilltop Biodynamic Syrah comes from the Chequera vineyard on the west side of Paso Robles. A select group of non-irrigated, centenarian Contra Costa vineyards continues to provide Mourvèdre for Cigare. A touch of Cinsault provides a very particular fragrance of flowers and aromatic herbs.
