On Tuesday April 21, 2020, Governor Baker announced that all Massachusetts K-12 public and private schools are to remain closed for the duration of the school year due to the ongoing COVID-19 health concern. Additionally, all non-essential DEEC programs are to remain closed until June 29, 2020.
