Follow Me

"18 As Jesus was walking beside the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon called Peter and his brother Andrew. They were casting a net into the lake, for they were fishermen. 19 "Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will send you out to fish for people." 20 At once they left their nets and followed him."

Matthew 4:18-20

These are the two simple words that Scripture records in the story of Jesus calling the first disciples. Jesus begins his ministry with a call to those who might listen. Follow me. This is the pursuit every Christian is on. What does following Jesus look like?

For Lent this year we're going to take a walk through the Life & Times of Jesus Christ. If you had been there some 2000 years ago for his ministry, what would you have seen, heard, felt, tasted, or smelled?

Can you imagine being next to the water of the River Jordan when Jesus was baptized? Imagine hearing water gently flow, feeling it's cool touch. During Lent especially we are challenged to feel the pain of Christ's temptation, the hunger and thirst he felt while in the desert. Think about the feeling of sitting on a grassy hillside while Jesus would teach or the taste of bread fresh in your mouth as Jesus prays "give us this day our daily bread." We often forget that these are real places, with real people, living in an extraordinary moment in time.

We'll try to capture some of that experience as we walk through his life leading up to the cross at Calvary. By highlighting some of the key moments in His ministry we will get a better look at what His time on Earth was like and how it pointed us to the Kingdom of God.

I am greatly looking forward to celebrating another Easter season with you and I hope that you will join us this Lent by hearing the call of Jesus in your life. Jesus stands nearby, harkening to you "Follow me". Let us prepare ours hearts for Easter by spending some time with Jesus.
