The pictures can be sent by phone, but must be emailed, NOT TEXTED, as we have discovered that pictures texted to the Cyclonaut's email do not have the same clarity. This is also true for pictures copied from Facebook.

All ride cancellation notices must be sent out the night before or by 6 AM the morning of the ride. Please remember that the final responsibility lies with each rider. If riders are not certain whether the ride is on, they should call the ride leader. The weather at the ride location is not always the same as where riders may live.
