



2018 Pass at the Park-poster artwork contest

Hatcher Pass Radio is looking for artwork to be used in the June 2018 Pass at the Park poster.

All artists of traditional media (oil/acrylic/tempera, watercolors, illustrations, prints) are invited to participate in this competition!

Entries should reference, either abstractly or not, the theme of MUSIC IN THE PARK during summer, specifically Iditapark in the CITY OF WASILLA.

Artwork needs be in vertical format and should be no smaller than 11"X 14" and no larger than 20"X 30"

No more than one entry may be submitted by one entrant and a completed entry form must be secured to the back of the artwork.

Each entry must be a completely original concept.

Entrants must be over 18 years old and be residents of the Mat-Su Borough.

Original art (i.e. drawings and paintings) should be dropped off at the studios of Hatcher Pass Radio, 5865 E. Bogard Rd. #2 M-F 9a-5p (except holidays). Please call ahead to make sure we haven't wondered off. 907-631-0877.

Deadline for submissions is 5 p.m. January 17, 2018. No late entries will be accepted.

The winning submission will be selected by radio station management and City of Wasilla Parks & Rec management. That decision will be final. Panel may chose not to select any of the artwork submissions.

All submission will be displayed during the City of Wasilla 101st Birthday Party, January 20, 2017 for public input.

The winning artist will be notified between January 22nd and February 1st, 2018, and announced on our website and social media after notification. Non-winning artists are not guaranteed to receive notification and will not be provided any feedback on their entry

THE WINNING ARTIST will receive \$500 and a framed copy of the final poster.

Non-winning entries will be returned to artists but must be picked up by February 28th or they will become property of Hatcher Pass Radio.

The winning artist with acceptance of the cash prize money gives ownership of the original artwork to Tanana Valley Television dba KNLT-FM Hatcher Pass Radio. KNLT-FM will retain all copy wrights for piece and may reproduce, in whole or in part, the artwork with no additional consideration to the artist. Any use or adaptation of the artwork is within the sole discretion of the Hatcher Pass Radio.
