**Public Information Meeting Scheduled for the
Warren County Transportation Technical Study Update**

The Warren County Department of Planning, in cooperation with the North Jersey Transportation Planning Authority (NJTPA), is working to develop an update to the County's Transportation Technical Study. An informational meeting has been scheduled to present the study and obtain comment from the public.

The public is invited to attend the meeting on Wednesday, May 16, 2018, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. at the Washington Township Municipal Building, 211 State Route 31 North, Washington, NJ 07882.

The meeting will include an open house, where members of the public will be able to view project materials and speak with County staff and members of the project team. In addition, this meeting will include a brief presentation on study findings, recommendations, and next steps.

This study is an update of the Warren County 2004 Transportation Technical Study that revisits and updates the goals, supporting data, and technical resources and methodologies to a time horizon of 2045, and incorporates findings and recommendations from various related transportation studies and plans.

This Warren County Transportation Technical Study Update (Technical Study Update) is envisioned as the first phase of a two-part undertaking to update the Transportation Plan Element of the Warren County Master Plan. The Transportation Plan Element will define and drive Warren's transportation planning and decision-making processes and guide the selection and advancement of priority capital improvements and policy measures.

The public is encouraged to attend and provide input to Warren County staff and project team members.
