ATTENTION:

All students & parents are required to <u>read this information thoroughly.</u> This letter includes a calendar. Significant time and effort goes into creating it. It's your responsibility to know when rehearsals, performances, and other activities are scheduled. Please take the time to get everything into your calendars so we can avoid conflicts. Please understand Marching Band is a class on your schedule, with required attendance and grades. Our band doesn't have "part-time" members. <u>ALL</u> rehearsals and <u>ALL</u> performances are required, period! Marching Band commitments come before employment and extra-curricular or club activities. Medical appointments should be made outside of rehearsal time whenever possible. Every absence matters, and impedes the progress of the entire band. (All reasonable efforts will be made to work out conflicts with other school activities.)

Marching Band Participation Fee

To cover camp expenses, music, equipment, dry-cleaning, etc., the fee is \$120.00. (Due the first day of camp - 8/23/21)

Performance Requirements

Pregame and MSBOA Show Music <u>must be memorized!</u> You'll be submitting performance recordings that will be assessed and contribute to your grade. Students will be permitted to use lyres for other special event music as needed.

Personal Bag for Camp

All necessary equipment needs to be obtained and kept in a backpack or duffle. The bag should contain everything needed including but not limited to: Refillable water bottle CLEARLY MARKED with your name, sunscreen, healthy snacks, a hat, and any other personal needs. Also included should be extra reeds, lubricants, swabs, and anything else you need to keep your instrument in top playing condition. Students will have a designated "spot" to keep their belongings, and will be prohibited from sharing items.

Pre-Season Camp Information - Band Camp attendance is required.

Who: All Marching Band Membership (Winds/Battery/Front Ensemble/Color Guard)\

When: August 19th for freshmen, new members and ALL BLUE SHIRTS / August 24-28th for all.

Uniform: During camp, students will wear their uniform T-Shirt at all rehearsals. (Distributed at the first rehearsal.)

Additional shirts may be purchased for \$10 each. Having an extra shirt or two is strongly recommended.

Bring: Instrument, Dot Book, Music, Flip Folder, Pencil, <u>Tons</u> of Sunscreen, Refillable Water Bottle.

(For returning members needing a replacement, Dot Books are \$15 and must be ordered by July 1st.)
