TO PARENTS:

The school can seldom do much toward the education of the pupil without the hearty co-operation of the home. We therefore, send you this report once each month to keep you informed as to the attendance, conduct, standing, and progress of your child; that you may be able to assist us in accomplishing the desired results. To this end, we request you to examine this report carefully each time presented, giving due credit and praise for all good marks, and remonstrating, if possible, the cases of all poor ones.

The following statements will explain our method of marking:

1. *90-100*.—We shall use 100 for ones, perfect; 85, very good; 75, good; 65, fair; 50, poor; 40, 30, 20, Marks below 20 are unsatisfactory.
2. *Task* column is. *Attendance* is based upon regularity and punctuality, and determined by deducting the number of 100, 10 points for each day absent, 5 points for being late early, and 3 points for each time dismissed early.
3. *Marks for Conduct* will fall about 100, 1 point for each fragmentary in conduct or act of disorder calling for admonition or reprimand, and 3 or 10 points for such serious misbehavior.
4. *Exercises* include order and neatness of written exercises, freedom of books and desk from disorganization, and neatness of trade, *Algebra*, etc. These are very important elements of school work.
5. *Class Exercise* Marks on account of neatness or otherwise, seldom made up, will decrease the monthly class standing in that month 3 points; and will very materially affect the monthly standing. Unavoidable absence is a subtraction, and a credit.
6. *Proficiency* is the general average required for promotion is 75, the minimum grade 60, the better subjects being valued at twice.
7. *Review* tests.—People perfect in *attendance*, *conduct*, and *neatness* will be placed upon the Honor Roll for the month. This list will be indicated by an H in this report column.
8. *Differences*.—A mark of distinction will be given for each study in which the monthly standing is 80, and a special mark with distinction if the final average is 80.
9. *Rank* is 95-100 is based upon the general average which includes the home subjects. Pupils are usually ranked at the close of a term or session.

Your frequent presence in the school room will be highly appreciated by both pupils and teacher.
