Essex Fox Hounds Hunter Trials

Conditions: All Classes to be shown over obstacles simulating natural hunting country. Judge to select horses which are the best working hunters. Horses and ponies to be judged on manners, way of going, evenness of pace, style of jumping, and suitability of mount to rider. Conformation will not count. Hunting soundness is required. Entrants will be excused after three refusals or an unintentional dismount. Unruly mounts may be excused at the discretion of the judge.

It is the riders' responsibility to be ready when classes are called. The Committee will not delay any events.

Riders are requested to wear informal hunting attire: seasonal jacket, ratcatcher, or shirt and tie. Children's division open to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. Three entries are required to fill each class, except in special classes such as family class, costume class etc.

Schooling Sat., September 12th, 1-5 and Mon. - Wed., September 14th-16th from 3-5 pm weather permitting. A fee of \$50.00 per horse per day will be charged. Please respect signs if posted "Course Closed." Please call Jim Gordan at 908-337-2546 to reserve a time to school your horses.

The property owners, the Committee, and the Essex Fox Hounds will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any horse, rider, equipment or spectator in preparation for or on the day of the Trials. The Committee reserves the right to decline any entry which, in its opinion, does not qualify.

Entries: Entries close Wednesday, September 9, 2015

Entry Fee - \$40.00 per class (except classes 12 & 13 are \$50.00 and class 14 at \$60.00).

Post Entry Fee - \$50.00 additional fee per rider.

Lunch break will be held after Class 14. Class 15, the Costume Class, will be held during the lunch break. Class 16 will start at 1:00 PM.

Reserved trailer/van parking: (space is limited).

\$75 - Field Parking adjacent to contributor/patron parking.

\$50 - Upper Gravel lot.

All general parking for trailers is in lower level gravel lot below club.

Patron Parking: Bring a picnic lunch and enjoy tailgating ringside during the event!

Best tailgate award to be presented following Class 18.

\$250 Benefactor Parking - includes premiere reserved ringside location.

\$150 Patron Parking - unreserved lower ringside or first row upper field parking.

\$100 Contributor Parking - first or second row lower field parking.

\$50 Friends Parking

All other parking in backfield or lower level lot.

Directions to the Essex Hunt Club:

1. From George Washington Bridge: take I-95 to I-80 West. Take I-287 South to Exit 22 for Bedminster. Follow Route 206 North (Chester) through 4 traffic lights. After 4th light, go 1 1/4 miles and make left on to Holland Road (across from Sunoco station). Essex Hunt Club is first driveway on right.
2. From South Jersey: take Parkway or Turnpike North to I-287 North (toward Somerville). Follow I-287 North to Exit 22B, Bedminster, and then follow directions above for Route 206 North.
3. From PA.: Take I-78 East to I-287 North (Morristown) and then take Exit 22B for Bedminster. Follow direction above for Route 206 North.

CLASSES

Trophy and six ribbons in each class, except as noted.

Special awards in Lead Line and Costume classes.

Classes may be split due to volume at the judges discretion.

8:30 AM – PADDOCK RING - JUDGE: DONNA MARKI

1. MR. & MRS. RICHARD V. N. GAMBRILL TROPHY
Equitation/Walk/Trot – Open to children 16 and under that are considered to be beginner riders. Eligible entrants may cross enter Class #2, #3 and #4.
2. **Equitation/Walk/Trot/Canter** – Open to children 16 and under that are considered to be beginner riders.
3. **Equitation Over Crossrails** – Open to children 16 and under that are considered to be beginner riders. Fences not to exceed 12”.
4. **Equitation Over Fences** – Open to children 16 and under that are considered to be beginner riders. Fences not to exceed 12”.

FLEDGLING FOXHUNTER TROPHY

Champion Equitation Rider – To be awarded to the horse & rider with the most points earned in classes #1, #2, #3, #4.

5. GEORGE NEILLANDS MEMORIAL TROPHY
Lead Line – Open to children, 8 years of age and under, who have not won a blue ribbon in a lead line class. To be shown on lead at a walk. Class may be divided if entries total more than 6. Entrants are **not** eligible for Classes 1-4.
6. CHOCOLATE BON-BON MEMORIAL TROPHY
Lead LineWalk/Trot – Open to children 8 years of age and under. To be shown on lead at the walk and trot. Entrants are **not** eligible for Classes 1-4. Class will be divided by age if there are more than 12 entries.

7. BRIARLY WOOD CHALLENGE TROPHY
Children's Hunter Over Fences – Open to children who have not reached their 18th birthday. Course of approximately eight fences not to exceed 2'6”.
 8. KINGIE SUGAR BOWL TROPHY
Children's Handy Hunter – Open to children who have not reached their 18th birthday. To be shown over a course of approximately ten fences not to exceed 2'6”. Entrants may be asked to trot a fence and /or halt and back.
 9. TUMMY MEMORIAL PERPETUAL TROPHY
Children's Hunter Under Saddle – Open to children who have not reached their 18th birthday. To be shown at a walk, trot, canter, and judge may request a hand gallop. Martingales are not permitted.

RADAR MEMORIAL TROPHY

Champion Children's Hunter. To be awarded to the horse with the most points earned 5, 3, 2, 1 in classes 7, 8, and 9, (half points in class 9). In case of a tie, judge may select the champion.

10. LITTLE BRONZE WING CHALLENGE TROPHY

Pony Club Hunter Over Fences – Open to children who are members of a Pony Club. Fences 2'6" for D Rating riders; Fences 3'0" for C Rating and above. Please indicate rating on entry blank.

11. ROBERT PATTISON MEMORIAL TROPHY

Open Equitation on the Flat - Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter. Judge may request additional tests.

GEORGIE STANLEY MEMORIAL PERPETUAL TROPHY

Champion Pony Club Rider. To be awarded on points on a single mount earned in classes 7, 8, 9, 10, and 11 (half points in classes 9 & 11). Please mark eligibility box on entry blank for Pony Club members. In case of a tie, judge may select the champion.

12. Family Class Under Saddle

Open to two or more members of the same family. To be shown abreast at a walk and trot in both directions. To be judged on performance, suitability and turn-out. Entry fee: \$50.

13. ESSEX FOX HOUNDS PERPETUAL TROPHY

Family Class Over Fences - Open to two or more members of the same family. To be shown tandem over an abbreviated course of fences not to exceed 2'6". Entry fee: \$50.

14. WOODFELLOW PERPETUAL TROPHY

Pairs of Hunters - Pair class to be shown tandem. Spacing to be consistent. Fences not to exceed 2'6". Entrants to change places where designated on course plan, and to jump one or two fences abreast. Team entry fee: \$60.

LUNCH BREAK

15. MUNCHKIN TROPHY

Costume Class – Open to individuals, pairs or groups up to four members. To be shown at a walk in both directions. Award categories: Funniest, Most Creative, Prettiest, Most Unusual. Trophy to Best Over All.

16. **MARY HOFMANN PERPETUAL TROPHY**

Green Hunter Over Fences

Fences not to exceed 2'6". Open to horses who have not hunted more than one season. Fences not to exceed 2'6".

17. **Green Hunter Over Fences** Open to horses who have not hunted more than one season. Fences not to exceed 2'6".

18. **Green Hunter Under Saddle** Open to horses who have not hunted more than one season. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter in both directions. To be judged on performance and way of going. Martingales are not permitted.

WHITE OAKS FARM TROPHY

Green Hunter Champion. To be awarded to the horse who has earned the most points 5, 3, 2, 1 in classes 16, 17 and 18 (half points in class 18). In case of a tie, judge may select the champion.

HUNT COURSE 3' 0" SECTION

19. **QUALIFIED HUNTERS FOR LADIES AND GENTLEMEN** - Fences not to exceed 3'0". Qualified Working Hunter – For horses that have hunted with a recognized hunt. Horses may not cross enter in sections A & B. Horses entered in classes 16, 17 and 18 are not eligible for classes 19 - 23.

SEC A - SECOND MIDDLEBROOK CHALLENGE TROPHY - Qualified Hunters ridden by ladies.

To be awarded to the best performance of a hunter ridden by a lady. Manners especially considered. Trophy and six ribbons.

SEC B - MASTER'S CUP PERPETUAL TROPHY – Qualified Hunters ridden by gentlemen.

To be awarded to the best performance of a hunter ridden by a gentleman. Trophy and six ribbons.

HOUNDSTOOTH CHESTERFIELD PERPETUAL TROPHY

To be awarded to the best performance of a heavyweight hunter (horse) in either the ladies or gentlemen's section.

20. **SECOND MONK JONES MEMORIAL TROPHY**

Open Working Hunter – Fences not to exceed 3'0".

21. **Open Handy Hunter**

Fences not to exceed 3' 0". Judge may request additional tests, including opening/closing gate, dropping a rail, mounting from the ground, etc.

22. MARVELOUS MAUDE PERPETUAL TROPHY

Open Hunter Under Saddle – Horses to be shown at a walk, trot, canter, and judge may request a hand gallop and/or halt. To be judged on performance and way of going. Martingales are not permitted.

23. MARY HANNAH HEROLD MEMORIAL TROPHY

Ladies Hunter Under Saddle. Open to horses ridden by a lady subscriber of a recognized hunt. Horses to be judged on soundness, way of going, and manners. Martingales are not permitted.

ELLEN ROGERS SCHLEY TROPHY

Champion Hunter. To be awarded to the horse with the most points earned 5, 3, 2, 1 in classes 19, 20, 21 (½ pts in class 22.) In case of a tie, judge may select the champion.

INVISIBLE INK TROPHY

Awarded to the **Best Turned Out Horse** in the Children's, Green, and Open Hunter Classes. To be determined by the judge.


VIEVA PERRIN MEMORIAL TROPHY

Leading Rider Award. To be awarded to the rider earning the most points on any number of mounts in any one division of classes. Divisions to count: Children's Hunters (Classes 7 - 11); Green Hunters (16 - 18) and Open Hunters (Classes 19 - 23).

24. WILLIAM CHADWELL MEMORIAL TROPHY

THE FIELD MASTER'S CLASS

Open to horses who have placed 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th in classes 7 - 11, 16 - 23. Horses to follow field master over an outside course and to meet situations that might arise in the hunt field. Fences not to exceed 3' 0". May be asked to trot a fence. Riders to change places after first "check". Judge will instruct field master. To be judged on performance, manners and way of going in the field.
