The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) requires the nation's schools to conduct detailed inspections to identify all asbestos-containing materials that might be present in the school environment. AHERA requires the inspection results and the associated Management Plan to be submitted to the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality (LDEQ). A copy of the Management Plan must be kept and maintained at the administrative office for review by the public.

Maurepas School maintains a proactive asbestos awareness program. Periodic surveillances (every six months) are performed by a qualified individual to assess the condition of the remaining asbestos containing building materials (ACBM). All of this information is updated in the Management Plan and available for review.
