



URGENT ANNOUNCEMENT

LINDMORE IRRIGATION DISTRICT GROWERS

Water Availability: It is estimated that the USBR will shut off “uncontrolled season” by mid-July to July 31, 2023. Therefore, you may continue to use all the water you want for the month of July 2023 at the rate of \$85 AF.

Beginning August 1, 2023 the following allocation and rate are announced:

Allocation: 1.25 acre per assessed acre

Rate: \$110 per acre foot

The Friant Kern Canal will be shut down. Therefore, the District cannot deliver water effective November 1, 2023. The canal will reopen around January 26, 2024. The District intends to be up and running again by February 09, 2024. You may use water for the balance of February. However, our system is old and leaks cause lines to go down for periods of time. **Reminder: All water allocated to landowners not used by February 29, 2024 will be billed to the landowner at \$110 per acre foot.**

If you do not think you can use all your allocated water, you may turn some or all of it into the District “Common Pool”. You must do this by August 31, 2023 by contacting the office and requesting it.

Landowners are encouraged not to pump water from the ground. The District will continue to maximize its recharge basin space by putting “Common Pool” water in the basins. If possible, landowners may request more supply from the “Common Pool”.

EKGSA: For EKGSA purposes, Lindmore ID is required to report all deliveries to landowner properties. Taking surface supply from Lindmore ID will therefore be added as a Surface Water Credit on your EKGSA Dashboard. Surface Water Credits remain on your Dashboard account in perpetuity or until used.
