## GENERAL INFORMATION

### DIRECTIONS TO THE TD and TDX SITE

From the North, take the Parks Highway to the Glenn Highway exit. At the bottom of the ramp, turn left. At the 5<sup>th</sup> stoplight, turn right onto Arctic Blvd and follow it out of town (becomes the Old Glenn Hwy). At the blinking yellow light, turn right onto Bodenburg Loop. Follow through five 90-degree turns (the last to the right), approximately 2.7 miles. The driveway will be the first on the left, just before a bank of mailboxes.

From the South, take the Glenn Highway to the Old Glenn exit (Palmer Alternate). Follow approximately 11.1 miles to the blinking yellow light and turn left onto Bodenburg Loop. Follow through five 90-degree turns (the last to the right), approximately 2.7 miles. The unpaved driveway will be the first on the left, just before a bank of mailboxes.

**OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS IN ENTRY FORMS REGARDLESS OF WHO MAY MAKE SUCH ERRORS**

**NO UNENTERED DOG WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE TRACKING TEST AREA**

**ALL DOGS WILL BE KEPT ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES OR RISK BEING MARKED FAILED WHETHER THE DOG HAS RUN OR NOT**

**BITCHES IN SEASON** may participate in accordance with AKC rules. The Tracking Test Secretary and Judges must be notified before drawing for tracks. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for these bitches will be held. Bitches in season will go on the fast track(s) laid and owners must take care as to not foul any area where other dogs may be.

**BY THEIR PRESENCE** on the tracking test grounds, all exhibitors and spectators agree to abide by AKC rules and Regulations and to follow the instructions of the Tracking Committee to the best of their ability. The owner or agent entering a dog in an Obedience Trial (or Tracking Test) does so at her/his own risk. OTCC, the Tracking Test Secretary, the Tracking Test Committee and the landowners of the tracking test site assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury to any dog or person on the tracking test site; or loss, damage or injury to any dog or person traveling to or from such site.

**FEEES MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ENTRIES.** Entry fee for the TD is \$100 and TDX is \$120, which includes AKC recording and service fees. No entry fees will be refunded if the test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of OTCC. Entry fees for alternates will be refunded if the alternate does not participate in the test.

**OTCC MAY CANCEL** this event in extreme weather conditions.

**THERE WILL BE NO EMERGENCY VETERINARIAN** on site for these tests. Contact numbers and addresses for emergency veterinary clinics will be available upon request and available at the test site on the day of the event.

**DRAWING:** For the Tracking Dog test, if more entries than the test limits are received, two drawings will be held to determine which entries will participate in each test. Each drawing will be random, the first will be for those dogs which have not previously earned a tracking title. The second draw will be for all remaining entries. One TD track may be held for a drawing of previous workers. For the Tracking Dog Excellent Test, if more entries than the test limits are received, a drawing will be held to determine which entries will participate in the test. When the limits have been drawn from all entries in each test, all remaining entries shall be assigned to a position on the alternate list for that test, corresponding to the order in which they were drawn. The drawing will be held on Wednesday, September 29, 2021, at 5:00 p.m., at 651 E. Railroad Avenue, Wasilla, AK. All interested persons are invited to attend.

**ALTERNATES LISTS** will be made for any given test where the number of entries exceeds the number of available tracks. Alternates will be advised of their position on the alternate list and given an opportunity to be at the test site in case of absent dogs or withdrawals. In the event of any absentees among the confirmed entries, the next alternate, in catalog order, who is present, will be allowed to fill the vacancy. Alternate entry fees will be refunded unless the alternate actually participates in the tracking test. Entry fees will also be refunded to any confirmed entry that does not participate in the test, provided that the Test Secretary is notified prior to the day of the test and provided that an alternate entry participates in the test as a result of the withdrawal.

AWARDS and ROSETTES will be presented to dogs who pass the TD test. A cash award of \$10, donated by Jane Knight in memory of Justice and Ticket, will be awarded to each passing dog and handler.

MAKE ALL CHECKS PAYABLE TO "OTCC" and mail fees, entries, and certifications to Jane Knight, PO Box 1644, Palmer, AK 99645. To drop off an entry, call (907) 440-9357 to make arrangements. No telephone entries will be accepted. All entries must be received no later than 8:00 PM Tuesday, September 28, 2021, after which time entries cannot be accepted or changed. The Event-giving club will collect the AKC recording fees (\$3.50) and service fees (\$.50). These fees are included in the entry fees.

TRACKING DOG TEST – Limited to four (4) dogs and alternates.

Entry Fee is \$100.00 for TD, which includes AKC recording and service fees. This TD test shall be for dogs which have received a Tracking Test Certification. Dogs that have previously earned the TD or TDU title may participate in the TD test. However, dogs without a title will be drawn first, per AKC regulations.

**\*\*NOTE:** Before a dog who has not previously passed an AKC TD or TDU class can be entered in a TDU or TD test, they must be certified by an AKC Tracking Judge or by a person/evaluator who has handled a dog to a TDX or VST title within the last ten years. This certification must be dated within two years for the date the test is to be held. In unusual circumstances, the AKC, through its Companion Events department, may issue tracking certifications based on statements provided by the handler concerning the dog's tracking ability. **All certification paperwork must be submitted by time of entry closing.**

TRACKING DOG EXCELLENT TEST – Limited to two (2) dogs and alternates

Entry Fee is \$120.00 for TDX, which includes AKC recording and service fees. This TDX test shall be for dogs which have received a Tracking Dog or Tracking Dog Urban title. Dogs that have previously earned the TDX title may participate in the TDX test if it will not result in a draw for alternates.

**All dogs scheduled to run TD and TDX Test tracks must be at the tracking area by 9:00 AM Friday, October 8, 2021, at which time there will be a drawing for the running order of each dog. The first track will be run shortly after the draw at the judge's discretion.**
