HIPPA Notice

Hope and Healing is required by law to protect the privacy of your protected health information. All information collected will be kept confidential, with the exception of the items listed below.

How your health information is used

- 1. A collaboration with other medical and psychiatric providers may be required to provide you the best medical care.
- Required healthcare information (such as dates of treatment, services provided, diagnoses, progress in treatment, etc) will be shared with your insurance company in order to bill and receive payment for services provided.
- Under certain circumstances, when required by law to share information without your consent.
 These situations include suspect of child or elder abuse and/or suspect another person may be in imminent danger.
- 4. Parents or legal guardians of minor clients have the right to access the clients' records.
- 5. If you have given written authorization to share your health information with others, including schools.

Your health information rights

- 1. You may review and get a paper copy of your medical records.
- 2. You may receive a copy of Hope and Healing privacy policies.
- 3. You may receive an accounting of when your information was shared without your consent.
- 4. You may request in writing your health information be shared with others. You may also opt at any time not to have your health information shared with others.

Hope and Healing Child and Family Counseling is required by law to maintain the privacy of your health information and provide you notice of our legal duties and privacy practices with respect to your health information. A copy of the Privacy Practices is available to you upon request.
