All persons appearing shall appear on land lines and not on cellular phones, and shall not use the speakerphone features of their telephones, in order to maximize all participants' ability to hear and be heard.

Due to public health concerns and in light of Administrative Order No. 2020 of the Arizona Supreme Court and of Judge Welty's Administrative Order No. 2020-043 (governing Maricopa County Superior Court) as well as the CDC's recommendations to physically distance from one another, the Maricopa County Superior Court's Jury Commissioner's Office has been instructed to suspend jury trials at this time.

Due to the spread of COVID-19, the Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order 2020-79 requires all individuals entering a court facility to wear a mask or face covering at all times they are in the court facility.
