Treasurer Report

The money market account has a balance of \$9,497.58 and the 12-month CD has a value of \$5,570.05. In comparing our budget to actual expenses to date, we have a positive balance of \$67. Keep in mind that September was the start of a new fiscal year. We received \$187 in membership renewals this month.

We passed our annual financial review that is required by the Fund under our billing agreement and the results have been submitted to the Fund.
