Scholarship applicants,

Each year, Carmel United Soccer Club uses a portion of their fundraising efforts to establish a scholarship fund for graduating seniors involved in the Club. This year, we are once again able to offer these scholarships for the graduating class of 2020. As a graduating senior involved with the Club, you may be eligible to receive a scholarship. The selection committee is now accepting written applications for consideration. Historically, the amount of the scholarship has ranged between \$200 and \$250 depending on the number of qualified applicants. Not all applicants may be selected for a scholarship award.

The criteria for consideration are as follows:

1. Applicant must be an active 2019-2020 member of the Carmel United Soccer Club as a player, coach, or referee. If there is not a viable team for the applicant to play on for the 2019-2020 season, the applicant must have at one time played within the club. Proof of this must be indicated in your essay.
2. Applicant must live in the Carmel Central School District.
3. Applicant must have a B average or better for his/her senior year and must provide a current report card with GPA and class rank signed by your guidance counselor.
4. Applicant must graduate by June 2020 and plan to attend a school of higher education.
5. Applicant must submit a 250-word essay on his/her goals for the future and include how the Club and how being involved in soccer has affected their lives.
6. Applicant must be available for a personal interview at the discretion of the committee.

Essay and proof of grades must be received no later than April 17, 2020. Please send all relevant documentation via mail OR email to:
