The undersigned expressly assumes such risk and waives any clam the undersigned may have against the Town of Estes Park, Colorado, its officers, employees, agents, volunteers and self insurance pool for any and all injuries incurred in said activities. This waiver includes any claims, damage, or injury as a result of any negligence and/or breach of warranty against the Town of Estes Park, Colorado, its officers, employees, agents, volunteers, and self insurance pool for any and all injuries incurred in said activities. The undersigned also assumes the risk and waives any claim for personal property damage, including damage to any equine owned or under control of the undersigned for any injuries suffered by said equine in the activities at the Events Complex.
The terms of this Release shall serve as a Release and assumption of risk for any heirs, personal representatives and administrators.
I have carefully read this Release and fully understand its contents. I am aware that I am releasing certain legal rights that I otherwise may have.
Warning Under Colorado Law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to section 13-21-119, Colorado Revised Statutes.
