

**Peruski, Adele L.**

Mrs. Adele L. Peruski, 82, of Bad Axe, died Saturday, March 22, 2008 at her residence after an apparent heart attack.

She was born Sept. 9, 1925 in Detroit. Daughter of the late Gilbert and Florence (Wainwright) Gervais.

Adele married George Peruski Oct. 30, 1954 at St. Mary's in Royal Oak. He preceded her in death Jan. 12, 1989.
