The evolution of a working vision for VIA was to establish a nonprofit organization to work toward ensuring financial autonomy in support of the IACS mission. The Founding Board approved a Conflict of Interest Policy and Organizational Bylaws in January of 2013. VIA was incorporated by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts on February 1, 2013 and filed for tax exempt status on March 15, 2013.

Our first Annual Meeting was held on March 25, 2013 at which time we selected an organizational logo, launched a website, elected board Officers and created short term organizational goals. The board set financial goals and established fiscal policy to include monitoring quarterly financial performance and overseeing an annual audit.


