

URGENT LEGISLATIVE ALERT/14th SENATE DISTRICT: TELL SEN. SLOSSBERG TO SUPPORT THE SEBAC AGREEMENT

State employees have voted to approve an agreement that, according to independent analysis, will save Connecticut taxpayers \$1.57 billion over the next two years and \$24 billion over 20 years.

This is an average of \$17,500 per worker.

While state employees are not the cause of the revenue shortfall driving Connecticut's budget deficit, we have agreed to step up and help solve it. But they felt it was a necessary sacrifice to protect the important services they've dedicated their lives to.

Through their unions, public employees have once again demonstrated the value of collective bargaining to solve complex problems in a fair way.

On July 24, the House of Representatives voted 78-72 to approve the SEBAC agreement.

Now it's time for the State Senate to do its work by approving the SEBAC agreement as an important step to protecting public services for our state, our cities and our towns.
