We are excited to tell you about this year's NJSUSBCBA Jamboree and Hall of Fame Induction Dinner.

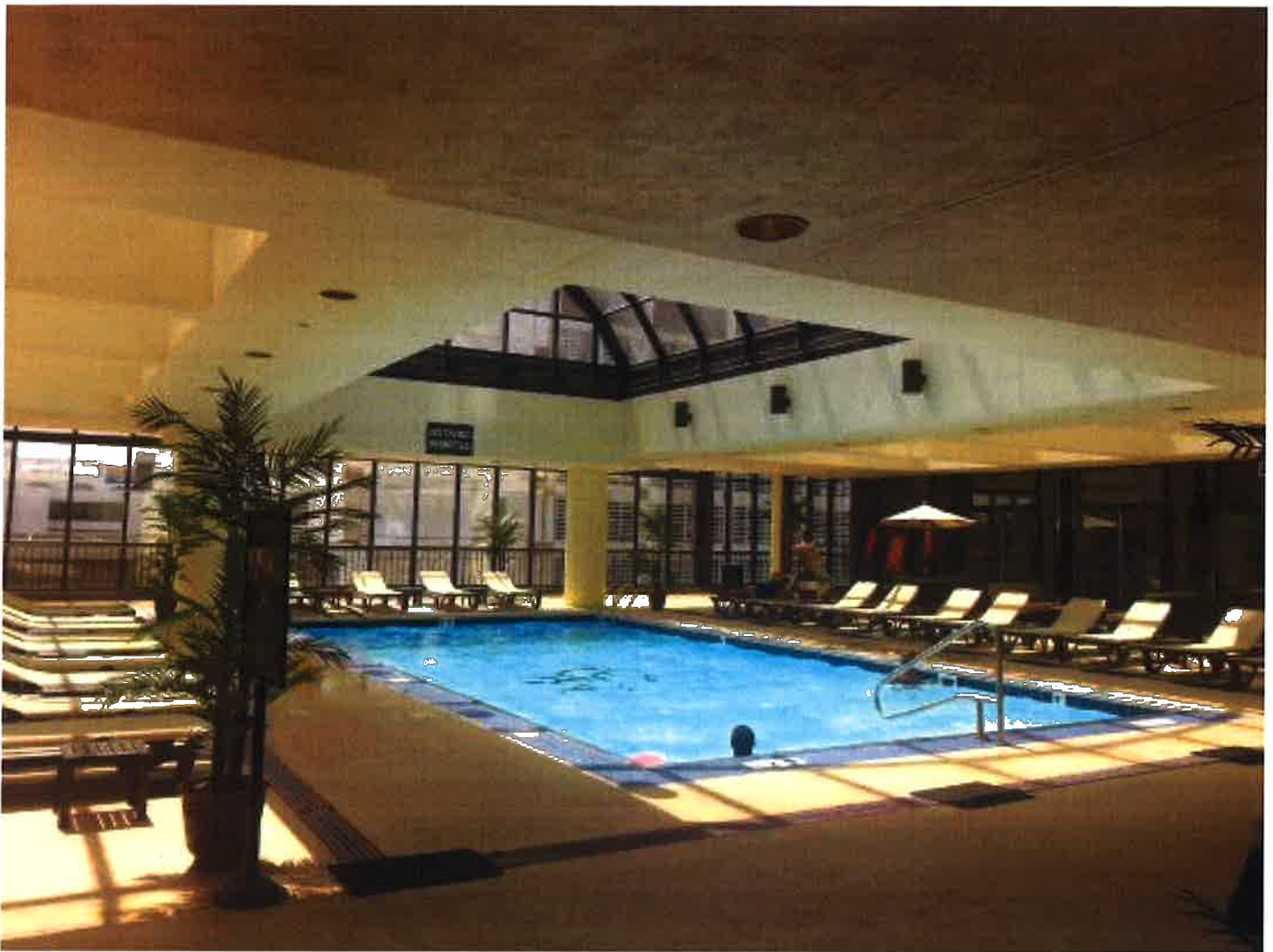
The Jamboree this year will be held at the "HISTORIC CLARIDGE HOTEL" in Atlantic City. The weekend of October 5th, 6th, 7th & 8th 2017.



The Claridge Hotel is a Period Boutique Hotel, loaded with amenities that, we are sure will please all those attending. They offer spacious rooms with either King or twin Queen Accommodations.

Other amenities at this location are an indoor Swimming Pool, as well as a complete health club with numerous exercise equipment and a Video Game Room for those so inclined.





A brief history on the Claridge, once a casino hotel, it was brought into the Radisson Hotels family a little over a year ago. It has under gone a complete renovation through 2016/2017 bringing it back to its former grandeur with furnishings and deco fitting that of its 1930's splendor but with modern amenities. The 400+ room hotel features beautifully decorated guest rooms and salon areas, all keeping with the Art Deco era of its building. The hotel has played host to numerous luminaries throughout its extensive history.

The 24 story hotel, once known as the "Skyscraper of the Jersey Shore" has a very prestigious history. During World War II, the hotel, like many of the hotels in Atlantic City, housed numerous branches of the service. The Claridge was host to the U.S. Air Force Personnel. Nearing the end of WWII, the Claridge, considered the most Elegant Hotel in Atlantic City at the time, hosted the meeting of the UN Relief & Rehabilitation Administration and Pact, where President Franklin D. Roosevelt, Soviet Ambassador Andrei Gromyko and England's Lord Halifax, signed this agreement.

Other extremely notable clients included Marilyn Monroe, Joe De Maggio, Frank Sinatra, Bob Hope, Princess Grace of Monaco, Al Capone, Clark Gable, Carole Lombard and Nucky Johnson have all stayed as guests in the Claridge.

Similar to last year, you will be on your own for breakfast. There are a number of options in the hotel, and of course the boardwalk is just steps away. The hospitality room this year will be limited to a Beer and Wine assortment, and of course we will have our special Friday Night Bash in our hospitality room on the 6th floor of the hotel, as well as Dinner on Saturday Evening for the Hall of Fame Installation and Induction of Officers.

The dinner this year will begin with a reception in the Main Salon of the Conference Center on the 2nd floor of the hotel. A Crudit  and selection of Cheese and Crackers will be offered, along with a cash bar. For the dinner we will start with a Caesar Salad and then there will be 3 choices for your Entr e selection, those being either Prime Rib of Beef with Horseradish Sauce, Breast of Chicken stuffed with Spinach, Sun Dried Tomatoes, and Parmesan Cheese with an Orange Port Reduction or Grilled Salmon Fillet with Mustard Dill Demi Glaze.

Of course our weekend would not be complete without our THEME! This year our Theme is OKTOBERFEST! We are planning another fun filled hospitality room with Music, Food, Entertainment and Prizes for everyone's enjoyment. So gentlemen don your Lederhosen and Ladies your Dirndl's and get ready to PARTY!

Of course we will also be hosting our Annual Golf Outing, details to follow, and the John McManus Bowling Tournament. We want to make sure everyone has a good time and a fun filled weekend.

The hotel also offers numerous other amenities. There are 3 lounges to enjoy, on the first floor is Malcom's Lounge, a cozy gathering place. On the 6th floor is the Twenties American Bistro & Bar, another cozy bar that has seen many celebrities such as Frank Sinatra, Dean Martin and the rest of the Rat Pack, along with Marilyn Monroe and Joe Di Maggio as its patrons, and finally the Vue on the 23rd floor of the hotel. A modern Bar Bistro with expansive patios on either side with 360 degree views of the Atlantic Ocean and Atlantic City. A Indoor Pool and a Video Game Room, also covered access into the Bally's Casino, right next door.

In the front of the hotel is Brighton Park with its magnificent fountain and the link to the famous Atlantic City Boardwalk.

The packages offered are for 1, 2 and 3 nights and include your Dinners, Hospitality Room and Hotel Parking. Like all the hotels in Atlantic City the parking concession is owned by an outside third party, but the Self-Parking for the Jamboree is included in the package. If you require Valet Parking there will be an additional \$ 6.00 per day charge.
