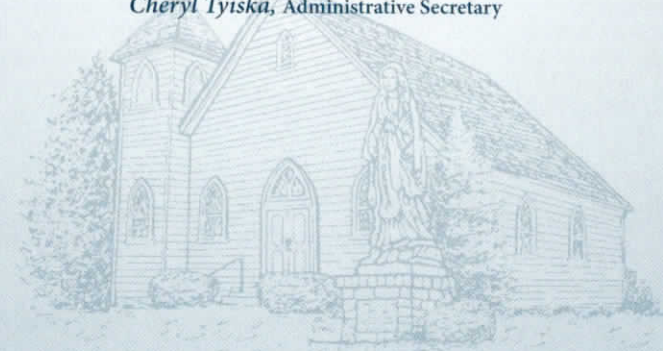

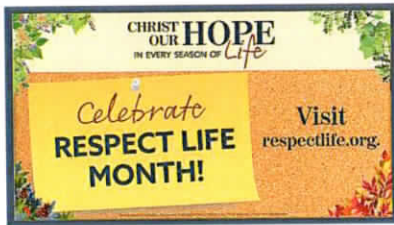

The apostles-who themselves lived, ate, and prayed with Christ-needed God's grace to carry out Christ's saving mission. We needn't be afraid to ask God to increase our faith. For if we have but "faith the size of a mustard seed," Christ can give us the power to do incredible things in service of the Gospel. So today, as we recommit ourselves to upholding the teachings of the Church on the inviolability of human life, may we recall that we have merely "done what we were obliged to do" as followers of Christ.
