The IDI–Inventory: What is YOUR Intercultural Competence?

The IDI–Inventory is one of the most rigorously tested tools for intercultural competence. It is able to provide individual and team assessment on a developmental continuum. This developmental approach to intercultural competence means that it is not about ‘good or bad’ but about building knowledge/skills for individuals or a team that increase effectiveness in the work place or study environment.

The tool is used in the corporate sector, governments, universities, NGOs and by individuals in 40 countries by qualified administrators and is available in more than 12 languages.
