General Rules

1. For horse show purposes, the age of an exhibitor will be considered as of December 1, 2021.
2. Dress is casual.
3. All riders cannot ride anywhere on the showgrounds without wearing protective headgear passing ASTM-SEI standards. Harnesses must be secured and if headgear has a brim it must be flexible or semi-flexible. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until their headgear is properly in place.
4. Cross entering between Pleasure classes and Hunter classes is permitted.
5. Management reserves the right to change the location of any class if necessary and to cancel or combine any classes if entries so warrant.
6. NO person will be allowed in the ring during judging unless on official business.
7. The State of Maryland requires that all horses and ponies must be in possession of a current negative Coggins Certificate taken within 12 months.
8. Vaccination Record/Proof of Vaccination for EHV1/4 (given with 180 days of show date) for every equine on premises.
9. Self Certification of Equine Health required for every equine on premises.
10. Champion and Reserve Champion Ribbons will be awarded in classes 1-27.
11. Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes.
12. Entry Fee will be \$15.00 per class. Jack Pot Jumper - \$20.00 per class

Lead Line Division

Open to riders 7 years of age and under. To be judged 50% on child's hands and seat and 50% on mount's quietness and suitability. No martingales. *Riders may compete in the Lead Line and Mini Short Stirrup division.*

1. Lead Line - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk with leadline attached.
2. Lead Line Walk Unattached - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk with leadline unattached.
3. Lead Line Unattached Over Poles - To be shown over 4 poles.

Mini Short Stirrup Division

Open to riders 9 years of age and under. To be judged 50% on child's hands and seat and 50% on mount's quietness and suitability. No martingales.

4. Mini Short Stirrup Walk - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk.
5. Mini Short Stirrup Walk-Trot - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot.
6. Mini Short Stirrup Walk-Trot Over 4 Poles - To be shown over 4 poles.

Beginner Rider Division

Open to riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. To be judged 50% on hands and seat and 50% on mount's quietness and suitability. No martingales.

7. Beginner Rider Walk - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk.
8. Beginner Rider Walk-Trot - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot.
9. Beginner Rider Walk-Trot Over 4 Poles - To be shown over 4 poles.

Short Stirrup Equitation Division

Open to riders 10 years of age and under. To be judged 50% on hands and seat and 50% on mount's quietness and suitability.

10. Short Stirrup Equitation Walk-Trot - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot. No martingales.
11. Short Stirrup Equitation Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.
12. Short Stirrup Equitation Over Fences - To be shown over 6-8 fences 18" in height. Martingales permitted.

Long Stirrup Equitation Division

Open to riders 18 years and under. To be judged 50% on hands and seat and 50% on mount's quietness and suitability.

13. Long Stirrup Equitation Walk-Trot - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk and trot. No martingales.
14. Long Stirrup Equitation Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.
15. Long Stirrup Equitation Over Fences - To be shown over 6-8 fences 18" in height. Martingales permitted.

Crossrail Hunter Division

Open to horses and ponies. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness.

- 16-17. Crossrail Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 crossrails 18" in height.
18. Crossrail Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.

Pleasure Horse/Pony Division

Open to horses and ponies. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness. No Martingales.

19. Pleasure Horse/Pony Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter.
20. Pleasure Horse/Pony Combo- To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot, canter. To jump 2 fences 2' in height.
21. Pleasure Horse/Pony Over Fences - To be shown over 8 crossrails 2' in height.

Hopeful Hunter Division

Open to horses or ponies. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness.

- 22-23. Hopeful Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 crossrails 2' in height.
24. Hopeful Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.

Open Hunter Division

Open to horses or ponies. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability and soundness.

- 25-26. Open Hunter Over Fences - To be shown over 8 fences 2'6" in height.
27. Open Hunter Under Saddle - To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. No martingales.

Jumper Divisions •• Will not start before 12:00 noon

Blue Ribbon Classes - A fault-free round (untimed) receives a blue ribbon.

Jack Pot Classes - The entry with the least amount of faults and the best time will be the winner.

Faults

- Knocking down a rail - 4 faults per instance
- Refusal or run out of a fence - 4 faults per instance
- Going off course or fall of horse or rider will result in elimination

In order to receive Series End Awards, horse/pony/rider must have shown in 6 or more classes in the division.

Ribbon winners in each class will receive points according to the chart below.

1st Place - 10 points	4th Place - 2 points
2nd Place - 6 points	5th Place - 1 point
3rd Place - 4 points	6th Place - .5 point
