During our Children Around the World Unit, we will celebrate different countries and their traditions. On Friday, March 2nd, we will celebrate Japanese Girls' Day. This is a special day when girls can bring in their favorite doll to be displayed in the Indoor Room. The children will be having a special snack on the yard, so watch for sign-ups for donations. The Pre K students (Happy Hippos, Groovy Goldfish, Funky Foxes & Excellent Eagles) will do origami in Miss Catalina's Art Class, so if any Pre K parents would like to come in and help with an origami lesson, please let the office know.

REMINDERS:

As per licensing, students MUST be signed in and out daily through our computer system. In the event that the internet is down, the paper sign-in is always available. If you are using the paper sign-in, you must write the time of drop off/pick up in the top box, and sign with your FULL LEGAL SIGNATURE in the box below. The school can get in trouble with Licensing if this procedure is not done correctly, so please make sure it is done daily. If you are having difficulty signing in and out on the computer, please notify the office right away so that we can re-program you into the system with a pin code.

We have noticed some families are having trouble once and a while with the front door keypad and unlocking the door. Please note that when the pin is entered correctly, you will hear a click at the door to let you know it is unlocked. If you have entered your pin and you do not hear a click, the door is not unlocked, and something was done incorrectly. If this happens, you will need to wait a moment to let the system re-set before trying your pin again.
