From I-40, Take Exit 196 at Moriarty and head south on H-41, travel 19 miles thru Estancia and take H-55 west. Continue to 10<sup>th</sup> Street and head north, take first right (east), go through gates to first building on left (north).

From South (H-60) proceed to H-41 junction and head north approx. 10.5 miles and take H-55 west. Continue to 10<sup>th</sup> Street and head north, take first right (east), go thru gates to first building on the left (north).
