Tutoring for Pay

To assure all students reasonable assistance without charge from their own teachers and to avoid placing a teacher in a position where there may by an appearance of a conflict of interest, teachers shall not receive money for tutoring any student they have in class or whom they have responsibility for evaluation or assignment.

Teachers may not tutor students for pay during their regular working hours. Upon the request of the parent and with the approval of the Administrative Director, paid tutoring will be allowed after school hours.
