Many healthy horses later, *Hearts Therapeutic Riding* emerged as some of these rehabilitated horses gained new purpose in serving children and adults with special needs and individuals recovering from trauma.

Therapeutic riding helps its riders with; cognitive, physical, emotional and social well-being. *Hearts Therapeutic Riding*, a program of ERCT, provides benefits in the areas of health, education, sport, recreation, and leisure. Throughout the Leander area, there are hundreds of individuals with special needs who experience the rewarding benefits of horseback riding with *Hearts Therapeutic Riding*. A disability does not limit a person from riding our horses.

In the process, *Hearts Therapeutic Riding* aims for its riders to:

- Build sense of self-worth, self-concept
- Improve communication
- Build trust and self-sufficiency
- Develop socialization skills and decrease isolation
- Learn impulse control and emotional management



My daughter, who has a developmental disability, was scared of horses, donkeys, and just about everything! After her first ride at *Hearts Therapeutic Riding*, that fear disappeared.

Since she has been riding, her speech and communication has exploded and her gross and fine motor skills have greatly improved. If I had one therapy for my daughter, it would be therapeutic riding. I do not know what I would have done without them or where my daughter would be.
