# ABOUT JACKSONVILLE BOOSTERS CLUB

The Jacksonville Boosters Club, Inc. was founded in 1963 to advance the general welfare and improvement of the community. Its early accomplishments include obtaining federal Historic District status for the City and saving historic, downtown buildings in the path of a highway project.



## WHAT WE DO

**Community Projects.** Boosters do projects to beautify, clean up or otherwise improve the City and properties in it. Recent projects include:

- *Restore and maintain Peter Britt Gardens*
- *Historic Jacksonville Home and Garden Tours*
- *Assist restoration of Jacksonville Arboretum*
- *Recycling program to clean up parks and streets*
- *Fly U.S. Flags on holidays and special events*
- *Build and/or restore public benches downtown*



**Home Tour.** This Tour raises money for the club by opening historic homes, gardens and buildings to public view. We create publicity, sell tickets, learn the histories of the houses featured in the Tour weekend and serve as docents.

**Membership.** We recruit and mentor new members and involve them in Club activities. We help create the annual membership directory and coordinate discounted-rate group membership in Mercy Flight ambulance service.

**Socials.** We host informal socials, an annual June Picnic and a lively December Holiday Party.

**Programs.** Our monthly meetings include speakers, entertainment, and refreshments along with club business.

**Publicity.** We create the Boosters Newsletter, arrange publicity for Boosters' activities and events, distribute promotional materials, and coordinate updates for the club website.

Today Club members engage in civic life by volunteering in support of other groups, helping with the clean up of the Jacksonville Historic Cemetery, assisting the Chamber of Commerce with the Victorian Christmas, and hanging lanterns for the Chinese New Year celebration. Boosters can also be found on the City Council, Boards, and Commissions.

Club members also are members of the Jacksonville Boosters Foundation, a 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation. Donations to the Foundation help support Peter Britt Gardens and Jacksonville Elementary School's music program and playground equipment and other Booster projects.

September - November and January - May, we gather at Bigam Knoll Campus in Jacksonville on every second Monday at 9:30 a.m. for refreshments, followed by a General Meeting at 10:00 a.m. for entertainment, discussion of local issues, and possible community projects.
